Club Response to New COVID-19 Restrictions

The Queensland State Government has today introduced new COVID-19 restrictions in response to a recent outbreak of the Coronavirus.

Under the Chief Health Officers' Movement and Gathering Direction (No. 3), the new restrictions will apply to the Ipswich, Brisbane, Logan, Scenic Rim, Lockyer Valley, Moreton Bay and Redlands areas.

Football at Western Pride FC may continue due to the strictly enforced COVID Safe plan that has been developed in line with State Government requirements.

Western Pride Football Club wishes to reinforce that the health and safety of our members, spectators, players, officials and our local community is our number one priority and as such only one parent per child can attend games.

All visitors attending matches at our venues are reminded that they are required to undergo temperature checks upon entry, must sign in and out of the venue, regularly sanitise and wash their hands and practise social distancing at all times.

Change rooms will only be available for our U20's and Senior FQPL sides and will be closed to all SAP and Junior NPL players.

All club amenities will operate under the 'get in, get out' model developed by the Australian Institute of Sport to minimising unnecessary contact in change rooms, bathrooms and communal areas.

Visitors who fail to comply with these simple requests may be denied access to the venue or removed.

Western Pride officials have been in contact with other local clubs who will be visiting our venues such as Lions FC, Olympic FC, Ipswich Knights and Rochedale Rovers FC, intending to take a collaborative and unified response to the new restrictions.

We will continue to monitor the situation and will update all stakeholders when further information is available.
