Day To Day Duties

Daily Tasks Include (but not limited to):

- Visit with potential customers to explain the service we provide
- Conduct site visits to determine project scope and price
- Set up portable fence for projects
- Load and unload goats from a trailer
- Conduct daily checks on herds to ensure the animals are present, healthy and safe, and monitor project status
- Schedule project start dates and communicate timelines to customers
- Be "on-call" for emergency situations at project sites (i.e. sick or injured goat, fence failure, damaged or downed fence)

Work Environment

Your office will have no walls, lots of fresh air and sunshine! You will use a company vehicle (truck and trailer, as needed) to travel to project sites. Some lifting and carrying are required. Ingenuity, creativity and problem-solving will be essential to setup fencing on-site. Desire to work with goats – and loving them doesn't hurt – is a must.

Skills That Matter Most

- Experience working with animals (goats would be a big bonus)
- Ability to communicate professionally and effectively with customers and co-workers
- Clean driving record and ability to drive a truck and trailer
- Availability to work from May 15 – August 15 (potentially through October 15)
- Ability to work on your own to complete tasks
- Ability to identify issues with animals and project site, and communicate them effectively and appropriately

Success In This Role

The successful candidate will be able to manage 3 groups of goats (up to 120 total), work well with team members to coordinate work schedules, and complete grazing projects to customers' satisfaction in a timely manner. The candidate will also care for the animals and equipment as if it were their own.

Compensation

Compensation will include a competitive hourly wage, cool goat-themed apparel, and use of a company vehicle for all work-related activities.
