The City of Sugar Land cannot forbid door-to-door Salespeople, Peddlers, or Solicitors. As a resident or property owner, if you wish to discourage some, you can fill out a form online that advises the City that Peddlers and Solicitors are not welcome and their entry on property at the provided address is forbidden. The form can be found at: sugarlandtx.gov/formcenter and by clicking on the link titled: "No Solicitation Registration". More information about solicitation can be found in the Code of Ordinances section within the tab labeled "Government".

Solid Waste Holiday Service Schedule 2022

Solid Waste and recycling collection will not occur on Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's holidays. If your collection day falls on one of the three specified holidays, you will receive service the following day. All other holidays will maintain the regular collection schedule.
