


Sparks


Dawn, Her Dad, and the Tractor



The Confessional




When a conflicted seminary student struggles with his desires that call his moral integrity into question he enlists the help of a new Al, Reba.


Getting Closer

Rainbow Flag Flying High





In the feature documentary Emergence: Out of the Shadows, the disparate journeys of Kayden, Jag and Amar converge around a shared sense of compassion and healing as they bravely convey their often heart-wrenching stories. Confronted with tradition and taboo in their Punjabi Sikh cultures, Jag's parents and Amar's mother choose love and support for their children, offering courage and

inspiration to individuals and communities struggling with acceptance.

Proud People



This film shares the life of Lori Lozano, a queer, chicana barber living in Austin, Texas. She has cut my hair for five years. Lori has a magnanimous, larger-than-life charisma that drew me in like so many other customers. Beneath that outward presentation, she is a struggling business owner, someone living with a harrowing medical diagnosis and no insurance, someone digging deep to understand her native heritage and her identity.



Haitian artist and activist Sanba Yonel creates a queer tribute to the Lwa, Vodou gods and goddesses who once inspired a revolution. In Haiti, men perceived as feminine are known as masisi. The word is often used as a slur on gay men, transvestites and non-binary folks. Sanba Yonel comments on the plight of the masisi who, faced with prejudice and hostility, find shelter in the religious context of Vodou.

coherence of secular thought."



This is Jessica is the story of a woman faced with an impossible choice between the life into which she was born, and the one she was born to live.

I Just Wish You Told Me



Jessie and Karen have been a same sex couple for thirteen years. When Karen goes into surgery and unexpectedly dies, a traumatized Jessie can't make sense of it. In her search, Jessie discovers hidden truths that disrupt and shake her confidence in their entire relationship.

Based on a true story, I Just Wish You Told Me, shows how betrayals in long term relationships, can lead to wounds that never heal.

Surviving The Silence



Surviving the Silence tells the story of two women in love who played a part in changing military policy, shining light on the unknown history of how a closeted colonel forced to expel an Army hero for being lesbian did so in a way resulting in re-instatement via federal court.

Years before Don't Ask, Don't Tell, Colonel Patsy Thompson presided over the review board that dismissed Colonel Margarethe Cammermeyer for being a lesbian. Although she had been in tough spots over the course of her 28-year service, this was the toughest. Presiding over this case forced Patsy to confront her own moral dilemma and her own secret: she too was a lesbian.

Perfect Peach Summers



Peach Summers (she/her/they/them), a beginner drag queen, prepares to host their first show in their hometown. A wig is snatched, however, when the last person they expect arrives hours before the event: Peach's father.

No Colour Darker Than Black




"Nach Schwarz kommt keine Farbe mehr" tells the story of a young Iranian man, who finds out that he feels attracted to other men. To

protect his family, he leaves his home and is from that point on his own. On his journey, he faces both understanding and acceptance as well as violence and repression.




Gospel Island



From remembering her childhood to her daily struggles, Grecia gives us a glimpse into the life of a transgender woman navigating the cruel streets of Tijuana, Mexico.




