POLICY ON TWO-STEP TB TESTING

The following are the rules and procedures on the Two-Step TB Testing from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

- The First TBV test is given with 0.1 ml of 5TU Tuberculin.
- The test is to be read within 48 to 72 hours.
- If there is a negative reaction to the first test a second test is to be given one to three weeks later.
- The second step should be placed in the opposite arm of the first test site.
- If the second step is negative no follow-up is required.
- If both steps are negative one yearly follow-up TB test is needed each following year.
- If either the first step or the second step is positive the individual is considered to be infected and should be given a chest X-ray.
