The Grand Knight's Message February, 2016

Dear Brother Knights, Sister Columbiettes, and friends,

In his 2016 Lenten message, Pope Francis called the faithful to place special emphasis on the spiritual and corporal works of mercy this Lent, taking into account the current Jubilee Year of Mercy. Pope Francis wrote, "God's mercy transforms human hearts; it enables us, through the experience of a faithful love, to become merciful in turn."

The **spiritual** and **corporal** works of mercy, the pontiff said, "remind us that faith finds expression in concrete everyday actions meant to help our neighbors in body and spirit: by feeding, visiting, comforting and instructing them."

"On such things will we be judged," he said.

The Lenten Season begins on February 10th, Ash Wednesday. Lent is a time of preparation for the death of Christ on Good Friday and His Resurrection on Easter Sunday. It is a period of 40 days of repentance, with prayer, fasting and abstinence, and Confession. As a way of helping us to remember the significance of this holy season and to assist us in our preparation for our Easter celebration, our Council will be hosting a Lenten Dinner on several Fridays during Lent. 
The Father Judge Council Adult Christmas Party is one of the major events of our Columbian year. The distribution of the Baskets of Cheer (at left) is almost an event in itself.




