Fr. Judge Columbiettes Dress a Girl Program

The Dress-A –Girl Ministry has grown to 60 participants, including many Columbiettes. Our monthly sewing sessions are the 4th Monday of every month and include approximately 20 participants with many seamstresses opting to sew at home! Tremendous support makes this project successful. The Father Judge Council, Knights of Columbus lets us use the hall. Saint Anthony’s parish and the community have provided fabric, trim, and talent as well as monetary donations, used to buy elastic, labels and bias binding. The purple Dress-a-Girl label costs \$0.10 and is placed on the front of every dress. Giving a girl a new dress raises her dignity as well as how she is viewed by others. The label indicates that this girl is under the care of an organization and it is hoped to reduce predation of these children.

We have donated the following in 2018:

- ⇒ 350 dresses
- ⇒ 355 dolls,
- ⇒ 313 pairs of undies
- ⇒ 104 pairs of flip flops (Boys don’t despair! Our group recently started making shorts for boys.)



Donations are carefully distributed to help insure that the dresses we lovingly make end up in the hands of needy children worldwide. Our dresses have gone to Ghana, Puerto Rico, Kenya, Haiti, Neyveli, India, Columbia and Guatemala! Father Saul Londono (Cali Columbia to Kenya), Sister Mary Martha (Petionville Haiti), the Youth Ministry at St. Anthony’s, and Father Charles (from Gnana Education and Charitable Trust in India) have helped us directly. Last week we heard that 100 humanitarian dolls were given to Mayan surgical patients in a remote medical clinic. Traditional clothing worn by these women prevented the dresses from being delivered.

Guatemala is rife with poverty, inequality, oppression and violence towards women. It is one of the worst countries in the western hemisphere for women due to lack of education, severe malnutrition, birth control and basic medical care. Although small dolls do not solve these challenges, we are hopeful it offers a glimmer of hope to a hurting heart. Over 2000 miles away, someone made a doll especially for them.


