




ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

The purpose of these awards (\$1,000 for 1st place and \$500 for 2nd place) is to provide financial assistance to an applicant to further his or her Catholic High School education. This scholarship is a onetime award per student.

- Applicant must be enrolled in a Catholic High School, grade 9, 10, 11 or 12 as of September 2019. Proof of acceptance is required. Grade average at time of application must be a minimum of 2.0 or a "C". Transcript of latest grades will be requested.
- Applicant must be related to a member of Fr. Thomas A. Judge Council, Knight or Columbiette, in good standing, living or deceased, or be a Squire.
- Application must indicate student's involvement in Church, Community or School activities and must include a statement from a Priest, program mentor, teacher, counselor, etc. as to student's character.
- An essay entitled, "How my Catholic background helps me be a better person for myself and for others." Essay should not exceed 150 type written words.
- Signature of parent or guardian is required.

Applications should be submitted to Fr. Thomas A. Judge Council, P.O. Box 1151, East Northport, NY 11731. Attn: Mark R. Guarriello, GK, and must be post marked no later than March 31, 2019. Scholarship award will be presented to the student at the Council's June 2019, meeting. Student's application will be given a numerical identification. Names will not be available to Scholarship Committee members.

The decision of the Committee is final.

On Friday, March 15th at 3:00 p.m., the Hour of Great Mercy, prayer warriors Maureen, Denise and Cara were standing vigil as witnesses. A car with an adult female driver with a teenage girl, and a teenage boy as passengers pulled into the PP driveway and proceeded to the parking lot. About 10 minutes later, the same car pulled out of the lot and parked in front of the witnesses. The driver was crying and told them she needed to talk to someone. She parked and joined them, then proceeded to share that the teenaged girl, Jessica (not her real name), had been pregnant with another baby a few months earlier and that she, this woman, had pressured her into an abortion. The woman felt crushed, extremely guilty, and did not know what to do about this second pregnancy. She had seen the 40DFL witnesses standing outside and felt drawn to talk to them.

A few minutes later, Jessica literally came tearing out of PP, running toward the witnesses on the sidewalk and crying, hoping that she would be offered help. Jessica had been heartbroken by the abortion of her previous child, so she became pregnant again, trying to make amends. Maureen talked to her and put her on the phone with a crisis pregnancy center to speak to a counselor. Jessica now plans to have an appointment at that pro-life center early this week. The adult female was given information about post-abortion healing and seemed open to seeking help.

Jessica and her companions had come to the sidewalk desperate and crying; after speaking with the witnesses, they left with hugs and smiles. They seemed hopeful and relieved!


