ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

The purpose of these awards (\$1,000 for 1st place and \$500 for 2nd place) is to provide financial assistance to an applicant to further his or her Catholic High School education. This scholarship is a onetime award per student.

- Applicant must be enrolled in a Catholic High School, grade 9, 10, 11 or 12 as of September 2020. Proof of acceptance is required. Grade average at time of application must be a minimum of 2.0 or a "C". Transcript of latest grades will be requested.
- Applicant must be related to a member of Fr. Thomas A. Judge Council, Knight or Columbiette, in good standing, living or deceased, or be a Squire.
- Application must indicate student's involvement in Church, Community or School activities and must include a statement from a Priest, program mentor, teacher, counselor, etc. as to student's character.
- An essay entitled, "How my Catholic background helps me be a better person for myself and for others." Essay should not exceed 150 type written words.
- Signature of parent or guardian is required.

Applications should be submitted to Fr. Thomas A. Judge Council, P.O. Box 1151, East Northport, NY 11731. Attn: Richard Fitzgerald, GK, and must be post marked no later than May 30, 2021. Scholarship award will be presented to the student at the Council's June 2021 meeting. Student's application will be given a numerical identification. Names will not be available to Scholarship Committee members.

The decision of the Committee is final.

The 40 Days Program ended on Palm Sunday, below are some accomplishments from the 40 Days for Life National Program From Around the Country

Pensacola, Florida—It's not just a women's issue

A young couple from *two states away* came to Pensacola for an abortion. The pregnant woman entered the abortion facility, but the father of her child stopped and accepted crisis pregnancy information from 40 Days for Life volunteers. A few minutes later, the man announced, "**I gotta' get her out of there!**" The man called the woman, who emerged from the abortion facility. "As they left the parking lot, they were smiling and waving," reported the Pensacola team. "**Praise God! Please pray for this young couple! We are so delighted about this turnaround, our first of this campaign!**"

Sheboygan, Wisconsin—Aborting the Disabled

When Jennifer received a prenatal diagnosis of trisomy 18, many thought her child should be aborted. "This means she had an extra 18th chromosome and a very dismal chance of life," Jennifer explained. "I guess it would have been considered a 'medically acceptable' abortion." But Jennifer knew better...and vowed to love her daughter whatever the future might hold. "God blessed us and let us meet our beautiful baby girl, Bernadette," Jennifer said. "We spent 108 days loving her until God called her home." Jennifer now joins the Sheboygan, Wisconsin 40 Days for Life Vigil to celebrate her daughter's short life. "On short notice, we had people join us for a prayer walk in her memory--and would like to make it an annual event," Jennifer said.
