Brothers, Sisters, Members of the Fr. Judge Family, and Friends:

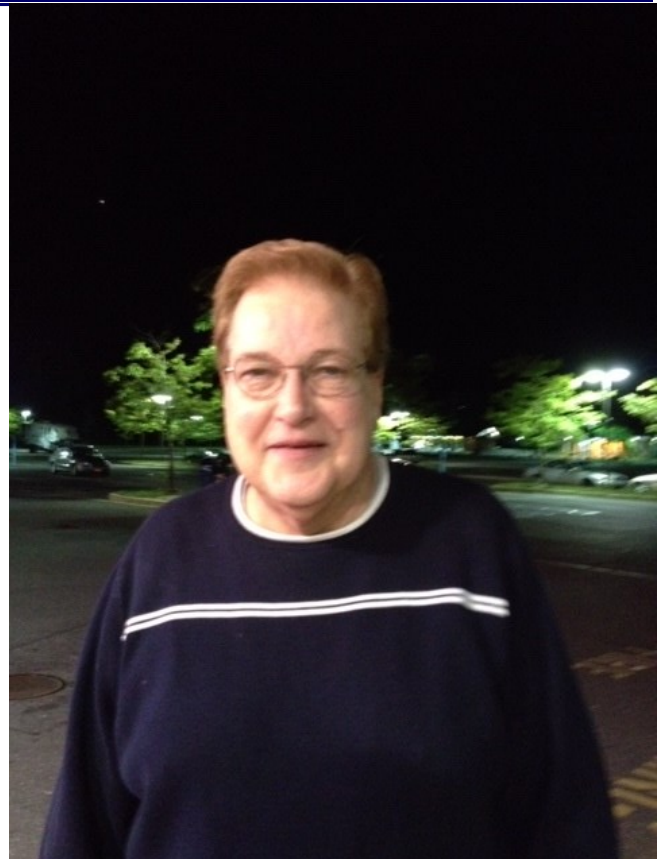
