## Fr. Judge Columbiettes—Dress a Girl Program

Dress-a-Girl is a ministry of love, kindness and sharing. It is a world-wide organization whose mission it is to bring dignity to women around the world since 2006 and to let girls know that they are worthy of respect, and that they are loved by God (visit the website: [dressagirlaroundtheworld.com](http://dressagirlaroundtheworld.com)).

So, we come together once a month to sew simple dresses for underprivileged girls. The dresses are sent to wherever there is a need. Our group is well-established (almost 4 years), yet growing (a core group of 25-30 volunteers), friendly, and welcoming.

This year, 429 dresses, 297 dolls, 149 pairs of flip-flops, and 50 pairs of shorts have been donated to children in many countries around the world, including the United States, Haiti, India, and Guatemala. Our most recent donations were sent to the Tutwiler clinic/school in Tutwiler, Mississippi - an extremely poor area of our country.

September is Life Insurance Awareness Month. Fr. McGivney lived both the social and the financial *insecurity* of a desperate family, with the breadwinner suddenly taken, that had to be supported. He left the seminary to work and support his mother and siblings. He didn't want other Catholic families to find themselves in such a predicament. That, and uniting men of faith, was the impetus for establishing our Order. Everyone who joined in those first years was insured; that was part and parcel of being in the organization. Now every member has a choice and every member should know what we do, and how we do it





