On Tuesday, September 22nd, Fr. Judge Council Participated in Fr. Seyfried Council's golf outing & fund raiser honoring M/Sgt. Christopher Raguso of Commack. (See photos below.) He was killed in action March 15th 2018, shortly after his 39th birthday, in a helicopter crash in western Iraq along with six other airmen in his Air National Guard unit.

M/Sgt. Raguso's unit, based at Long Island's Grabeski Airport, was serving in Operation Inherent Resolve, fighting ISIS alongside the Kurdish forces to eliminate Islamic State terrorists in the Syrian battlegrounds.

His wife Carmela personally visited each foursome on the golf course thanking them for honoring her fallen husband. She said it meant so much to her and her young children that we were honoring her husband and keeping his memory alive.

Our Council hosted the 25th Annual Sam Russo Golf Classic charitable fund raiser on Monday, September 28th (see group photo) at the beautiful Crab Meadow Golf Course overlooking Long Island Sound. This year our council honored long-time member and dearly departed brother knight Santo (Sam) Russo who passed earlier this year on Easter Sunday. Sam was a very active member of our council and most notably organized and ran the council Golf Classic for its first five years.

The advance forecast for this year's Classic was very rainy and windy, which gave this year's cochairmen Rich Ronde and Don Maltby cause for much anguish right up until Monday morning when the day dawned with no rain. As it turned out, it was a beautiful fall day temperatures in the 70s and the sun peaking through the clouds as the morning progressed!

We had a record turnout of 140 golfers who had to get up early for this year's 6:30 a.m. start for the day's scheduled activities. The event kicked off with a continental breakfast, putting contest, practice range & 18 holes of golf at the course. After golf, the hungry golfers were treated to a delicious BBQ lunch, which included a two hour open bar.

Lunch was followed by a special tribute to our brother Sam honoring him for his many hours of dedicated service and contributions to our council over the years. Sam's lovely wife Jackie, who was accompanied by her daughter Carmela and grandchildren Jackie & Jake, were presented with a commemorative plaque and a beautiful floral bouquet.

As happened in last year's putting contest, this year we also had three players each of whom holed an almost impossible putt under the watchful eyes of contest officials.
