

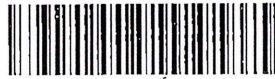

I. STIPULATION

WHEREAS: The parties agree that:

1. This case is an appeal from the decision and/or alleged inaction of a local school board made pursuant RCW 28A.645 which allows any individual who believes he is aggrieved by the decision of a school board to appeal to the Superior Court.

2. The South Kitsap School Board took board action on a matter on July 21, 2021, and allegedly did not take other actions, which Mr. Daily appeals herein.

3. Mr. Daily timely filed his appeal with the Court on August 18, 2021.

4. There has been procedural confusion in advancing this matter.


1 **THEREFORE, THE PARTIES STIPULATE:** The parties through their respective
