CALL TO ORDER

President Gattenby called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm and provided information regarding the nature of the meeting. Governor Inslee issued Proclamation 20-28 which in part prohibited public agencies subject to the Open Public Meetings Act from conducting meetings in person to curtail the spread of Covid-19. President Gattenby invited written comments by email or mail to the SKSD District Office.

Establish Agenda: Director Daily requested that Item 5.01 Resolution No. 1320 Emergency Suspension of Policy be removed from the agenda. The Board discussed.

DISCUSSION

Superintendent Winter updated the Board on the following topics:

- Remote learning model we've distributed over 2,000 Chromebooks to students and working on
 internet access; we've printed over 700 packets for students without online access; teachers are
 providing feedback to students; families are encouraged to contact their teacher or principal with
 questions; we're working on grading practices; both certificated and classified staff, including teachers,
 paras, counselors, nurses, and our social worker are checking-in on students, communicating with
 parents, and assessing each situation to determine follow-up as needed.
- Graduation and Summer Programs the last day of school is June 19; we're hoping to offer some type of recognition/celebration later in the summer for graduating seniors; we're discussing summer programs, including meals, and looking at funding.
- Learning gaps students attended two-thirds of this school year before closure; we're planning strategies to catch students up during the summer and/or at the beginning of the next school year;
- Food and Nutrition Services we've served over 40,000 meals and delivered to over 70 households; they are partnering with local business to procure food and supplies and donating each day's leftover meals to Helpline.
- Budget we've been conservative with spending assuming we will not be reimbursed and using
 overtime sparingly; we're tracking any expenses related to Covid-19 and carefully monitoring to make
 sure expenditures are benefiting students; we're also beginning to develop the 2020-2021 budget.

Director Berg reminded the Board of the timeline to file their PDC reports;

The Board discussed the proposed board referral request form and a sample for a new format of monitoring report.

Monthly Financial Report for February 2020: The Board reviewed the February financial report and discussed the format and timing of the reports. The February 2020 financial report can be found on the April 15, 2020 Board Meeting Agenda.
