CONVENE

Call to Order: President Berg called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm and provided information regarding the nature of the meeting.

Pledge of Allegiance: President Berg led the flag salute.

ADOPT AGENDA

RECOGNITIONS AND CELEBRATIONS

Superintendent Comments:

- Superintendent Winter recognized Directors Diehl and Sebren in their last board meeting before their term expires and thanked them for their service and commitment to South Kitsap.
- He also urged the Board to focus on working together to support the goals of the District.

FOCUS ON RESULTS

Facility Long-Range Planning Advisory Committee Report: Committee Chair Lee Fenton presented the Committee's quarterly report focused on the Existing Facility Assessment Summary Review.

Results 2: Evidence for 2.1.3 Science: Assistant Superintendent Dr. Tom Edwards, Executive Director Lisa Fundane't and Science Curriculum Coordinator and SKHS teacher Stephanie Winslow reviewed the District's science programs, science pathways available to students, and student achievement data from grades 5, 8, and 11 from the Washington Comprehensive Achievement of Science (WCAS). Dr. Edwards also shared that the three middle schools have completed phase one of their work with the teacher development group. Ms. Fundane't provided an update on health curriculum adoption. The committee met November 4 to review the 10 state approved curricula. They will meet again to narrow down to the top two programs and then staff and community members will have the opportunity to review the programs and provide feedback.

This presentation is evidence of compliance for Results 2.1.3. The entire Results 2 will be monitored in May when evidence for all elements have been presented.
