Processing Events

The following information is a guideline suggested by our veterinarian for optimal cattle health and performance. The team at Cattle Empire is here to help you succeed. If after reviewing this document you have questions or concerns, please contact us to discuss.

Branding

- Intranasal 3 Way MLV (Inforce 3, Nasalgen IP, etc.
- Pasteurella/Manheimia (Nuplura, Once PMH, One Shot, etc.)
- Clostridial
- Castration/Banding

Post-weaning

- If calves are on ranch longer than 45 days after pre-weaning, then this event should occur 14-21 days before shipping to Cattle Empire
- 5 Way MLV (Because they should be separated from cows)
- Clostridal

Pre-weaning

- Calves must stay on ranch for 45 days following this event
- Train calves to eat from bunk, drink from waterers
- Fenceline weaning practices are preferred, but not required
 - 5 Way (MLV or Killed) depending on if calves are going back on to cows
 - Pasteurella/ Manheimia (Nuplura, Once PMH, One Shot, etc.)
 - Clostridial
 - Dewormer

Maximum incoming weight:

- -825 pounds for heifers
- -900 pounds for steers.
