WINDSONG POOL RULES 2023

ALL PERSONS USING THE POOL SHALL DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK. They shall be solely responsible for injury in connection with such use.

- ➤ The Windsong pool is only available to registered Windsong residents and their guests.
 - Residents must have a registered key card to enter the pool area.
 - Guests must be accompanied by a registered Windsong resident.
 - Contact Kerri Pfau at 317-432-5122 or Kerri_Pfau@yahoo.com for a key card. Only one key card will be issued per household. The key card replacement fee is \$25.00.
 - Residents who are not current on Association dues will not be allowed to use the pool.
 - Residents and guests must sign in on the sign-in sheet near the gate.

POOL HOURS: The Windsong pool is open daily from 6am-10pm with designated Adult Swim, Family Swim, and Open Swim times.

Adult Swim – No lifeguard on duty. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK WHEN NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY. Only residents 18+ years may enter. No children are allowed during this time.

Family Swim – No lifeguard on duty. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK WHEN NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY. Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent during this time.

Open Swim - Trained lifeguards will be on duty. Lifeguards are not responsible to monitor the wading pool. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

Due to budgetary considerations, Open Swim hours are reduced for 2023.

> The following are **NOT** permitted:

- Pets, glass, smoking, alcoholic beverages, gum
- Disposable diapers. Swim diapers or plastic pants over cloth diapers are allowed.
- Balls or toys not intended for "in pool use." No squirt guns, large inner tubes, or large floats.
- Running, pushing, dunking, foul language, hanging on the rope, "chicken fights," or rough horseplay
- Diving or flipping into the shallow end
- Inappropriate swimwear
- Activities that, in the opinion of the lifeguard, are considered dangerous or an annoyance to an individual or others

Diving board rules:

- Only one person allowed on the board at a time
- Only one bounce allowed on the board
- No flips of any kind allowed off diving board
- Swimmer must jump straight off the board, not to the side
- After jumping/diving off the board, swimmer must immediately swim to the side of pool
- No one is permitted to hang on the board

Additional Rules:

- Fifteen-minute breaks will occur every hour during Open Swim so that adults may swim
 while children rest. All swimmers under the age of 18 will remain out of the pool during each
 break. Children are not allowed to have any part of their body in the pool during the breaks and
 must remain at least two feet from the pool edge for their own safety.
- All food must be consumed within the designated fenced-in area. Beverages in plastic containers are allowed in the pool deck area.
- Cars, golf carts, and other motorized vehicles are not allowed in the upper lot except for pool employees and those with disability plates/placards.

Disciplinary actions will be enforced as follows:

- FIRST WARNING: Swimmer will be given a verbal warning
- SECOND WARNING: Swimmer will be required to sit out for 10 minutes
- THIRD WARNING: Swimmer will be sent home for the remainder of the day
- REPEATED RULE VIOLATIONS MAY RESULT IN LONG-TERM RESTRICTION OF POOL PRIVILEGES

As we do not have additional monitors at this time, please help by being vigilant. When you are at the pool and see something that does not seem right, whether it is regarding the gate/lock, sanitation issues, bather load, or any other issues or concerns, please report it to the lifeguard or contact any of the board members listed below.
