## **WINDSONG POOL RULES 2024**

## THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY AT ANY TIME ALL PERSONS USING THE POOL SHALL DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK. They shall be solely responsible for injury in connection with such use.

**POOL HOURS:** The Windsong pool is open daily from 6am-10pm with designated Adult Swim and Family Swim times.

**Adult Swim: 6-10am and 8-10pm.** Only residents 18+ years may enter. No children are allowed during this time.

**Family Swim: 10am-8pm.** Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult during this time.

**POOL RULES:** Repeated rule violations may result in long-term restriction of pool privileges.

- > The Windsong pool is only available to registered Windsong residents and their guests.
  - Residents must have a registered key card to enter the pool area.
  - Guests must be accompanied by a registered Windsong resident.
  - Contact Christi Thieme at 317-809-4777 or cthieme00@yahoo.com for a key card.
    Only one key card will be issued per household. The key card replacement fee is \$25.
  - Residents who are not current on Association dues will not be allowed to use the pool.

## > The following are **NOT** permitted:

- Pets, glass, smoking, alcoholic beverages, gum
- Disposable diapers. Swim diapers or plastic pants over cloth diapers are allowed.
- Balls and toys not intended for "in pool use" including squirt guns, large inner tubes and large floats
- Running, pushing, dunking, foul language, hanging on the rope, "chicken fights," and rough horseplay
- Diving and flipping into the pool
- Inappropriate swimwear
- Activities that could be considered dangerous or an annoyance to others

## Additional Rules:

- All food must be consumed within the designated fenced-in cabana area. Only beverages in plastic containers are allowed in the pool deck area.
- Cars, golf carts, and other motorized vehicles are not allowed in the upper lot except for pool employees and those with disability plates/placards.
- Activities at the pool may be recorded by security cameras to aid in the investigation of damage, injury, or rule violations.
