## WINDSONG POOL RULES 2025

---

**ALL PERSONS USING THE POOL SHALL DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK AND SHALL BE SOLEY RESPONSIBLE FOR INJURY IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH USE**

**CHILDREN UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESPONSIBLE ADULT AT ALL TIMES**

**POOL HOURS: 6am – 10pm** Limited lifeguard coverage is provided on weekends only.

**Adult Swim: 6-10am and 8-10pm.** Only residents 18+ years may enter. No children are allowed during this time.

**Family Swim: 10am-8pm.** Children must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

**POOL RULES:** Rule violations may result in long-term restriction of pool privileges.

- The Windsong pool is only available to registered Windsong residents and their guests.
  - Residents must have a registered key card to enter the pool area.
  - Guests must be accompanied by a registered Windsong resident.
  - Contact the Security Coordinator at 317-809-4777 or cthieme00@yahoo.com for a key card. Only one key card will be issued per household. Replacement fee is \$25.
  - Residents who are not current on Association dues will not be allowed to use the pool, and their key cards will be deactivated until dues issues are resolved.
  - Do not provide access to anyone who do not have a working key card. They should contact the Security Coordinator for resolution.
- The following are **NOT** permitted:
  - Pets, glass, smoking, alcoholic beverages, gum, and foul language
  - Disposable diapers. Swim diapers or plastic pants over cloth diapers are allowed.
  - Balls and toys not intended for “in pool use” including squirt guns, large tubes and floats
  - Running, pushing, dunking, hanging on the rope, “chicken fights,” and rough horseplay
  - Diving and flipping into the pool
  - Inappropriate swimwear
  - Activities that could be considered dangerous or an annoyance to others
- Diving board rules:
  - Only one person allowed on the board at a time
  - Only one bounce allowed on the board
  - No flips of any kind allowed off diving board
  - Swimmer must jump straight off the board, not to the side
  - After jumping/diving off the board, swimmer must immediately swim to the side of pool
  - No one is permitted to hang on the board
- Additional Rules:
  - All food must be consumed within the designated fenced-in cabana area. Only beverages in non-glass containers are allowed in the pool deck area.
  - Cars, golf carts, and other motorized vehicles are not allowed in the upper lot except for pool employees and those with disability plates/placards. Violators may be towed at owner’s expense.
  - Patio table umbrellas must be closed after use
  - Activities at the pool may be recorded by security cameras to aid in the investigation of damage, injury, or rule violations.
