


8th Annual























For several years, Dar es Salaam Neurotrauma Course has trained young surgeons and nurses in essential, up-to-date techniques and evidence-based management principles for brain and spinal trauma relevant for East Africa.

This year, we extend our agenda to include dedicated sessions in skull base anatomy and skull base surgery, discussion on neurotrauma management based on original data collected at our center; a practical session on saw bones for beginners during the BOOT CAMPS organized by the biotechnical engineers and a full day oriented for critical care management of neurotrauma patients, getting full access to MOI ICU live cases. There is also a five day practical of live surgery where residents will get acquainted with finest skills from the experts. During the course the residents can also get chance to discuss their clinical cases in the discussion session.

It is intended that this course will establish neurosurgical care through a "train the trainer" model. At the conclusion of this course, participant's knowledge and competence will be evaluated based on their increased ability to:

- Understand health systems for management of acute neuro-axial illness and inherent challenges
- Correctly manage traumatic brain and spinal injury in emergency room
- Correctly identify indications for surgical interventions in brain and spinal trauma
- Classify cervical and thoracolumbar trauma fractures of the spine
- Know radiological features of degenerative spinal disorders and current surgical techniques for their treatment
- Understand classification and management of skull base and spinal tumors
- Understand 3D microsurgical anatomy and surgical approaches to skull base lesions
- Understand approaches for treatment of anterior and posterior circulation pathology
- Practice and handling of fine microsurgical instruments
- Understand the basic Neurocritical care approaches to neurotrauma patient
- Understand the current concepts in global neurotrauma,
- Get in-depth reviews and prospects for joint research and projects
