Lesson #20: Progressive Revelation

OPENING

Teacher: Remind children: 1) sit quietly, rest their arms 2) lower their faces to listen to the prayer and show respect to God. Ask who can recite opening prayer:

"I bear witness, O my God, that Thou hast created me to know Thee and to worship Thee. I testify, at this moment, to my powerlessness and to Thy might, to my poverty and to Thy wealth.

There is none other God but Thee, the Help in Peril, the Self-Subsisting." – Bahá'u'lláh

• Ask the children if any of them know a prayer that they could recite for the class.

QUOTE:

"Ask a Bahá'í to deny any of the great Prophets, to deny his faith or to deny Moses, Muhammad or Christ, and he will say: I would rather die. —'Abdu'l-Bahá

- Is there one God?
- Can we really know Who God is?
- Why does God send Prophets to us?
- Why dose God send Prophets at different times?
- What big holiday is coming up and what does it signify?
- Why do Baha'is believe in Jesus?
- Why do Baha'is believe in Baha'u'llah?
- Discussion: The Prophets of God and God

Note: Baha'is believe Buddha, Moses, Abraham, Jesus Christ, Mohammad to name just a few. They are Prophets that came at different times to help humanity.

Jesus' Disciples asked Him how to pray to Him and He gave them the Lord's Prayer:

Our Father Who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done. On earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen
