Office for Children with Special Health Care Needs (OCSHCN)

Enhancing the quality of life for Kentucky's children with special health care needs through quality service, leadership, advocacy, education, and collaboration.

Early Hearing Detection and Intervention (EHDI) and Audiology Services: Did you know that about 3 in 1,000 babies are born with permanent hearing loss? It's one of the most common birth defects in America. OCSHCN ensures that all newborns are tested for hearing loss and follows up on those who may have failed their screening. OCSHCN's Audiology program includes hearing conservation, diagnostic testing, hearing aids, and programming for cochlear implants.

Kentucky Early Intervention Services (KEIS) KIPDA Region Point of Entry: KEIS is the statewide early intervention program serving children with developmental disabilities from birth to age 3. OCSHCN is the point of entry (POE) for families living in Bullitt, Henry, Jefferson, Oldham, Shelby, Spencer, and Trimble counties. Services and supports are provided to families to enhance the growth and development of infants.

Specialty Medical Clinics:

Autism • Cardiology • Cerebral Palsy • Craniofacial • Eye • Hemophilia • Neurology • Orthopedic • Otolaryngology

OCSHCN clinics offer a family centered, team approach to care, beginning with medical care from pediatric specialists. During each visit, patients (birth to 21 years old) and families may also receive nutritional services, social services, care coordination, and other services from a staff of caring professionals. Some clinics include more than one physician to address multiple needs. Financial assistance is available for eligible families.

Case Management: Through case management a registered nurse works with the family to create the care plan that is right for the child and family. The plan will include the recommendations of doctors and other professionals and will respect the needs of your child and family. Case Management is available to any family with a child with special health care needs in Kentucky, regardless of their diagnosis. This service meets the family's comprehensive health needs through communication and available resources to promote high quality, cost effective services for the child.

Transition Services: Children and their families are connected with resources to help them plan for the future. OCSHCN focuses on transitioning from infancy into pre-school (KEIS program) and from childhood into adulthood (Specialty Medical Clinics).

Family to Family Health Information Center: OCSHCN is home to Kentucky's Family to Family Health Information Center (F2F HIC). The F2F HIC helps families make informed choices by providing support, information, resources, and training. The F2F HIC connects caregivers with other caregivers who have experienced similar challenges. In addition to serving families, the F2F HIC provides training and resources to organizations. The F2F HIC is staffed by "support parents" who are care givers of children with special needs.

Youth / Young Youth Services

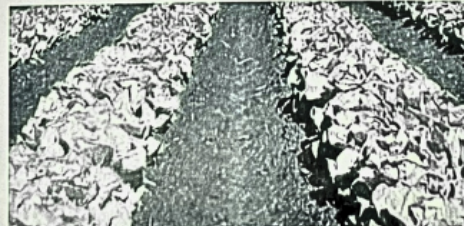
Services specifically catered to youth participants. **Youth** are considered **ages 18-24**, while **young youth** are considered **14-17 years of age**. Career counseling and workplace training is available. Additionally, mentoring with comprehensive counseling and guidance would also lead youth towards strengthening in leadership while acquiring new occupational skills needed as they enter the workforce **JOB-READY!**

- MET will support participant youth with opportunities for tutoring and dropout prevention.
- Financial Literacy, ESL Classes, Computer based classes
- Help with GED or High School Diploma equivalent attainment.

How is eligibility determined?

- Must be an eligible **seasonal/migrant farmworker (MSFW)** adult, youth **OR** be considered as a dependent of either, and,
- Be a **low income individual or family** whose total family annual income does not exceed the higher level of the poverty line.

Housing Assistance

Housing assistance includes direct payments for emergency and temporary housing needs. These needs would be considered as a utilities payment for the farmworkers home. Other **HOUSING** assistance includes help to farmworkers migrating from one agricultural seasonal job site to the other. Please speak with a MET employee for further information on Housing Assistance for MSFW's.



If you are an MSFW Texas-homeowner, ask about our NFJP Housing Program.

Related Assistance

All services are focused on the clients needs. Services are provided through a case-management approach emphasizing customer choice and may include career services and training. Help is also available for farm workers with a specific need during or in-between agricultural employment.

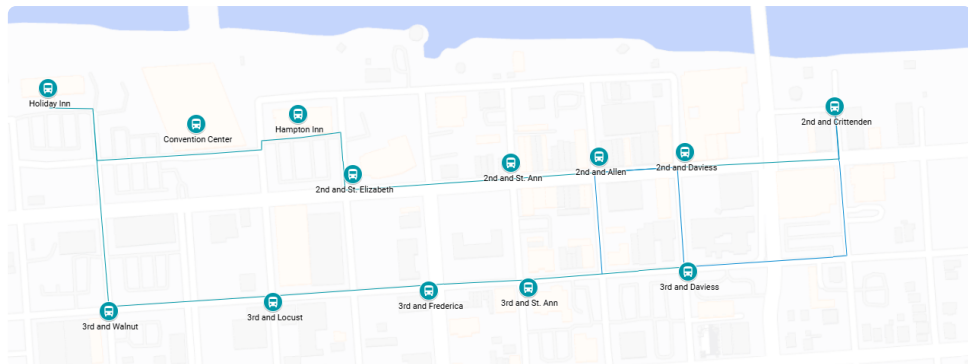
