INVITATION TO BIDDERS Sealed bids for furnishing the necessary materials, equipment, and labor for LCWCID1 projects located at CR 602/Zaleski NS Ditch and CR 602/Coffee Slew in Dayton, Texas, will be accepted by the Liberty County Water Control & Improvement District No. 1, Dayton, Texas beginning March 16, 2023, until Friday, April 14, 2023 at 3:00 p.m. Construction activities associated with these two projects consist of the removal of the deteriorating existing, culverts, replacing them with concrete block culverts and widening the road creating a sturdy safe structure for the passage over these two drainage ditches. Bid packets will be available on the LCWCID1 website: lcwcid1@info.com and will require utilizing the rules and regulations stated in the LCWCID1 Drainage Criteria Manual also posted on the website or, you can contact Leonard Vyoral, at 832-444-3935 for more information. Sealed Bids must be mailed to LCWCID1, P. O. Box 1386, Dayton, TX 77535, Attention: Leonard Vyoral beginning March 16, 2023, with a deadline of 3 p.m. Friday, April 14, 2023. Bids will be opened and reviewed upon receipt, any bids received after the deadline will not be opened. LCWCID1 reserves right to accept or reject any or all bids, and to waive any informality in the bids received. All contractors/subcontractors whose System for Award Management (SAM.gov) registration is not active or that are debarred, suspended, or otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation on federal assistance programs may not undertake any activity in part or in full under this project. Bids will be held for a period not to exceed 30 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award and will be awarded after approval of the LCWCID1 Board of Directors. Upon award, the successful bidder will be required to furnish W-9 and General Liability Insurance prior to the start of the project.



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
