We are disappointed to announce that the Soup Kitchen will not be holding our annual Pancake Breakfast and Silent Auction due to the Covid-19 pandemic. As a team, we feel the safety of the community is far more valuable than holding our fundraiser.

Since the Rose of Sharon Soup Kitchen moved to our new location, we have served over 26,000 meals. We have made those meals at home and brought them in for our hungry patrons to eat since our kitchen is still being brought up to city code. We are committed to meet needs and share the Gospel no matter what it takes. Some days we are without electricity or plumbing, yet we just keep 'plugging along' doing ministry.

We have also given out over 1,700 food boxes to hungry families in need across North Alabama. Each family that receives a box, enjoys fresh produce, milk, eggs, meat along with non-perishable items. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, The Rose of Sharon Soup Kitchen is serving a more diverse population of the community due to job loss and furloughs. We have seen nurses, engineers and restaurant employees seeking food and assistance from us during these uncertain times.

Most importantly, we have had the privilege to lead 23 souls to Jesus Christ! The Rose of Sharon is dedicated to show God's love and grace by meeting physical and spiritual needs to the hurt, lost, lonely and forgotten.
