It has been a year of changes at the Rose of Sharon Soup Kitchen and with the Lord's guidance we have managed to successfully navigate these trying times. We are very close to finishing construction on the new building and be up and running as a soup kitchen again. I am so pleased to tell you all that since January even though most days we were challenged with lack of electricity, plumbing, air conditioning and running water we have continued to serve those less fortunate by providing:

- 26,000 meals
- 3224 Food Box
- 135 motel nights for families and those in poor health
- Placed 6 homeless families into apartments
- 2,973 Devotionals

Along with these services we continue to love on the less fortunate by collaborating with other organizations to provide drug/alcohol rehabilitation services, utility assistance and assistance for babies and children. The Rose of Sharon has provided a homeschool during quarantine, provided on-site Covid testing, flu shots and orchestrated a blood drive for our community.

But most importantly, we have had the opportunity to lead 16 people to give their lives to Jesus Christ! GLORY!
