A motion was made by Ann Marie Saam to accept the Treasurers Report and pay bills, seconded by Donna Tedesco, with all in favor.

Committee Reports-

- No Committee reports were reported.

Unfinished Business-

- One bid was received for patching pot holes from Brian Zembrycki Excavating at a cost of \$7,000. A motion was made by Tom Yale to accept the bid and seconded by Donna Tedesco with all in favor.
- Bill Pykus did the grating and pot hole filling on East Mountain Road. Last year, the borough hired Suite Kote to put calcium on the roadway, but President Saam noted that she had spoken to Alex Komar of Thompson Twp. and he can apply it for a cost of \$700, which is considerably less than Suite Kote. Council agreed to have Mr. Komar apply the calcium and President Saam agreed to contact him.
- It was noted that the borough still needs a third auditor.
- A computer has not yet been purchased for the borough as Secretary O'Reilly is waiting for the stores to reopen rather than buy one online.

New Business-

- Donna Tedesco suggested purchasing railings for the bathrooms to make them more handicapped accessible. Mike Fortuner agreed to look into where they can be purchased and the cost.
- Discussion was held on applying for grants next year to do extensive road repairs.
- It was agreed that where several small potholes need to be patched, Brian Zembrycki should cut out the entire section and repair it, rather than filling them individually. Tom Yale has agreed to meet with Brian and discuss this.

Motion to adjourn was made by Donna Tedesco and seconded by Mike Fortuner, with all in favor.
