- Addressing concerns raised by residents- During the February meeting two council members mentioned that concerns were raised to them. Both members had explained to the residents that they would need to attend the next Borough Council meeting. Donna Tedesco had asked the secretary to consult the solicitor to ensure they were addressing concerns properly. Also, how to direct residents in the event the concern needed immediate attention.
- The solicitor had indicated that if a resident would like to report an ordinance issue, they can utilize the form on the website and attend the monthly Borough meeting to lodge their complaint. If the issue is emergent, they can contact the county office that would handle the disturbance.

New Business-

- Donna Tedesco raised the following topics for discussion:
 - Add EDP layment for East Mountain Rd on the April Agenda. Discussion was held and council decided to obtain a quote from Midland Asphalt since it held up well since it was laid last year.
 - Contact Don Bennett to conduct his rounds. Council discussed that this is usually conducted between March and July. Secretary will contact Don Bennett.
 - Sweeping Mausoleum Rd.- Council discussed the since the chips have had time to set that there shouldn't be an issue with sweeping the road in the spring. Council discussed the amount required to solicit bids is \$10,500. Given that this should fall within the price range the secretary will obtain a quote from Barhite Excavating for a quote to sweep and vacuum Mausoleum Road. Council member Mike Fortuner volunteered to contact the PennDOT, as they may have a solution to sweep and vacuum the road.
