








## LIVING IN GEORGIA SEASONS



Spring (March - May)

**Summer (June to August)** 

Summers are hot and humid, particularly in the southern and central parts of the state.


Temperatures often reach the 90s°F (32-37°C), and humidity can make it feel even hotter. The northern parts of Georgia, like the mountains, remain somewhat cooler. Thunderstorms are common during this season.





Fall (September to November)

Fall is mild and one of the most enjoyable seasons in Georgia. Temperatures drop to the 60s and 70s°F (15-25°C), with less humidity. This season also brings beautiful foliage as the leaves change colors, especially in the northern regions.

#### LIVING IN GEORGIA FOOD CULTURE








