THE MAGNITUDE OF THE NEED

A Life-or-Death Crisis

South Sudan has the **worst maternal and infant mortality rates in the world.**

- Over **1,100 mothers die for every 100,000 births**
- In **rural areas**, most women give birth **without trained assistance**
- Fewer than **1 in 5 births** are attended by skilled professionals
- Long distances, poor roads, and poverty delay emergency care

For many women, childbirth is not a moment of joy—it is a moment of risk.

WHAT WE ARE BUILDING A Safe Place to Give Birth

The Malual Community Maternal Health Clinic will provide:

- Antenatal care and pregnancy screening
- Skilled, attended deliveries
- Emergency stabilization and referrals
- Postnatal and newborn care
- Family planning and health education

Serving families within a **20–25 mile radius**, the clinic will support **150–250 safe births each year.**



WHY THIS CLINIC MATTERS

In a state with only ***one hospital to serve more than 1 million people***, this clinic is severely needed. The clinic will be located in Riang Adhau, a rural area of Northern Bahr el-Ghazal State.

What changes when skilled care is available:

- Mothers survive childbirth
- Babies live past their first days
- Complications are detected early
- Families avoid devastating loss

This clinic transforms life chances—for women, children, and the entire community.
