Observers have seen:

- More ballots than voters who voted
- Election seals in the garbage
- Copies of ballots mixed with ballots
- Incorrect addition in final vote totals
- Ballots left unlocked overnight
- Seals on ballots being broken
- Election officials violating court orders

Training covers how to protect our elections through observation & verification of these systems:

Sept 15 ~ LOGIC AND ACCURACY: Observe voting machines testing, who is conducting the tests & are best practices followed?

Sept 17 ~ IN-PERSON VOTING: Learn how to compare the number of voters to the number of ballots cast & document results in the polling place.

Sept 22 ~ VOTER ROLLS: Learn how to request voter rolls & check they are accurate. Voter rolls determine who gets to vote.

Sept 24 ~ VOTE-BY-MAIL: Mail-in ballots are at risk from both the possibility of rejection and fraud. Learn how to observe this process and what you can do to help ensure that valid votes get counted and not rejected.

Sept 29 ~ AUDITS: Learn to evaluate post-election audits, How many races & ballots are audited? Are discrepancies discovered? How are they addressed?

Oct 1 ~ ELECTION NIGHT REPORTING: Track vote totals as they are collected and reported by counties, states, media & election night reporting outlets.

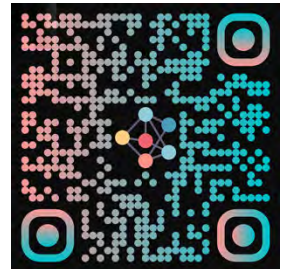

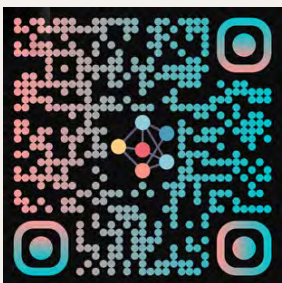
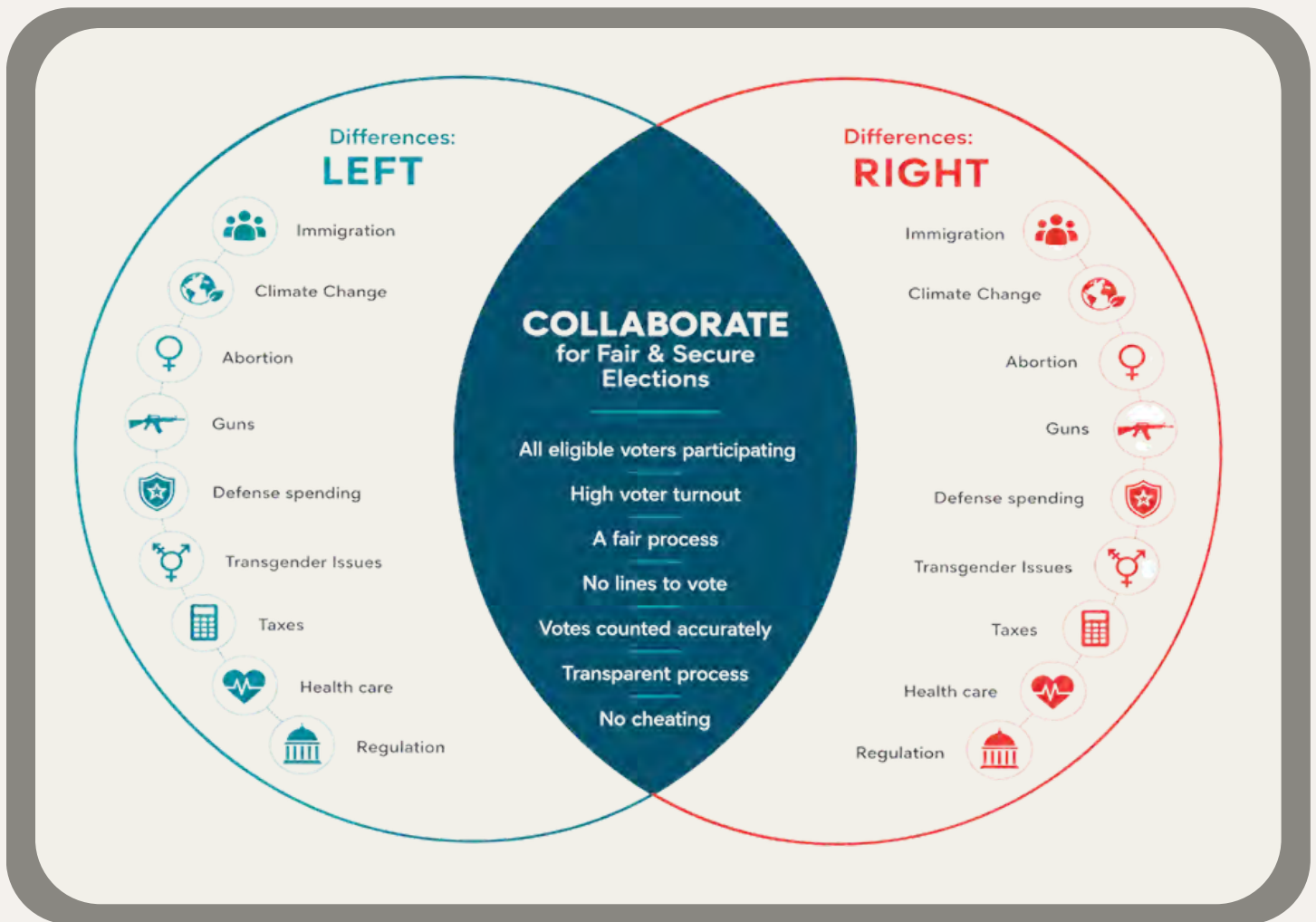

The goal is to give volunteers an opportunity to actively participate in monitoring and protecting their local elections, in order to increase confidence in election results, identify trouble spots and reduce the chance that U.S. elections will be plunged into chaos, or even violence, following an election.



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What are the risks of election subversion in the midterms?

Concerns about the election are different on the left & the right

Concerns On the Left

- People being removed from voter rolls illegally
- Intimidation at the polls
- Polling places being moved
- Early voting being cut back
- Refusal to accept election results
- Federal government interfering
- Redistricting

Concerns On the Right

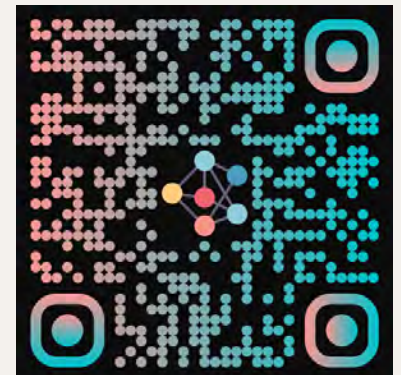
- People being added to the voter rolls illegally
- Mail-in ballots being used for fraud
- Electronic voting machines counting votes incorrectly
- Illegal voters will vote
- Electronic poll book issues

Shared Concerns:

- Foreign & insider attacks
- The other side will cheat & the election will be unfair

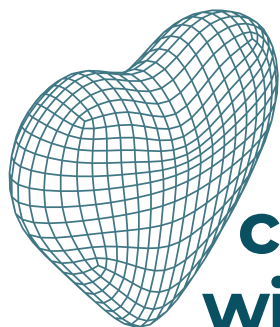

ABOUT US:

SMART Elections is a non-partisan organization dedicated to transforming U.S. elections by expanding public oversight, improving security, and advocating for fair, accessible voting. Our mission is to ensure that elections are transparent, have high participation and inspire public confidence.

OUR HISTORY: We were founded in 2019 by an election security journalist, a filmmaker and a computer security expert. Our leadership has 20 years of experience in election reform.

OUR GOAL: We want elections that are transparent, have high participation and inspire public confidence. We want you to have full confidence that your vote is counted correctly.



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HOW TO GET INVOLVED:

- **We have partnerships with orgs around the country.**
- **Your team members fill out a simple google form & we take it from there.** We have a volunteer management system that helps us stay connected with observers throughout the process. Your organization will have access to that data at any time.

HOW MUCH TIME WILL IT TAKE? **Observers will want to dedicate a minimum of 2-3 hours for training, or more, if they want to learn about more aspects of the election.** Observing itself can take an hour to several days if the observer decides to do more - like several days of Early Voting.

WHY OBSERVE?

- **Problems with U.S. elections are not new.** It is not always comfortable to discuss them, but we must if we want to improve our electoral process
- **Often technology is overlooked,** but tech is at the center of our elections now. We register, vote and count votes with technology. It is imperative for the public to have a better understanding of, and more confidence in, this technology that impacts almost every aspect of our lives.

WHAT WILL I BE DOING? **You will be observing different aspects of the election,** from the testing of the voting machines, to observing voters cast their ballots, to the auditing of the vote count.

WILL I HAVE SUPPORT? **Yes.** We develop networks at the local, state & federal level, so you have support during the process & in reporting what you find.

CAN PROBLEMS BE SOLVED THIS WAY? **Yes. We have located and started solving many issues this way.** We have been doing election observation for 5 years, and each election we get better at locating and solving problems.

OBSERVER'S STORIES: Alice started observing with SMART Elections in Tulare County, CA in 2025. She observed mail-in ballot processing. She said in her report, “Most of my time was spent talking to the supervisor in charge of vote counting ... She was very friendly and answered all my questions ... ***Her wish was that more people would come to observe.***”

OBSERVER'S STORIES: Symonne observed the Logic & Accuracy testing of the voting machines and the canvass of the ballots in Wexford County, Michigan. ***The election officials said it was the first time anyone had come to observe, and they were very informative, answering all her questions.*** She found out several important pieces of information:

- The testing of the ballots was done well and open to the public
- ***The testing of the software was not open to the public*** and not done by election officials. So it was impossible to tell if it was being done correctly, or at all.
- The audit is done after certification of the election in Michigan, so it does not serve to check if the election results are correct.
