FORMAT: 1 Qualifying Round, Stroke play with cut to be made at the end of the round. No more

than 2 "byes" in any flight – match play to begin after qualifying round.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all female amateur golfers at least 16 years of age who are residents of S.I. or

members of a local S.I. golf club. Current USGA index will be used to determine which flight you will be playing in effective on the deadline date. If you do not have a USGA

index you will be placed in the Championship Flight.

ENTRY FEE: \$45 per person. Includes lunch on day of the qualifying round.
