Colors of Life Oracle Deck

Card Reading Guide

1	The Name	The card name: what it means to the reader, what it means to the person being read for, the personal associations both carry into the reading, and any facts either knows or can recall about it.
2	The Number	The Pythagorean value of the card name: each number holds a core vibration.
3	Color, Flow and Movement	The dominant colors, the direction of energy, and the quality of movement in the image.
4	Chakra Association	Applied when a single color is clearly dominant: connecting that color to its center in the 9-chakra model and its deeper meaning.

Layer 2 · The Number

Each letter carries a number. A is 1, B is 2, and so on through I at 9. The pattern repeats: J is 1, K is 2, continuing through the alphabet. Add the value of every letter in the card name. If the result has two digits, add those digits together. Keep reducing until one digit remains. That is the card number.

1	Leadership and Beginnings	Independence, originality, initiative, the pioneer standing at the threshold
2	Cooperation and Sensitivity	Balance, partnership, duality: the self first encountering the other
3	Creativity and Expression	Joy, communication, the voice that names what it sees
4	Stability and Discipline	Foundation, hard work, structure: the builder's patient hand
5	Freedom and Change	Adventure, the senses, movement: life experienced in full color
6	Harmony and Responsibility	Nurturing, service, care: the warmth and weight of the home
7	Introspection and Wisdom	Spirituality, analysis, the seeker: the examined inner life
8	Power and Abundance	Authority, achievement: the force that moves the world
9	Completion and Compassion	Universal love, humanitarianism: the full circle closing

Layer 3 · Color, Flow and Movement

Read the direction and quality of movement in the image. Most cards carry multiple movements. Identify the dominant one first, then read the others as supporting layers.

Quality	Direction	Meaning
Ascending	Bottom to top	Increasing energy, rising
Descending	Top to bottom	Lowering energy, settling, releasing: energy diminishes and returns as it moves down
Left to Right	Left toward right	Forward in time: approaching, becoming, arriving at what comes next
Right to Left	Right toward left	Backward in time: receding, returning, dissolving into what came before
Expanding	Outward from center	Spreading, widening, growing in scope: the opening of what was held inward
Contracting	Inward toward a point	Narrowing, concentrating, focusing: the gathering of what is essential
Rotation	Circular or spiral	Integration, cycles, continuous becoming: the direction of the rotation (clockwise forward, counterclockwise returning) informs meaning consistent with left-right and ascending-descending movement
Angular	Diagonal combinations	Multiple forces at work simultaneously: steeper angle means greater intensity

Layer 4 · Chakra Association

This system uses 9 chakra centers, from Root to Soul Blueprint. Applied only when a single color clearly dominates the card. When the image holds many colors equally, this layer rests. When one color speaks loudly: as in Magnum Ferrari or Poppies: it enters the reading.

Color	Center	Number	Function and Meaning
Red	Root	1	Grounded: earth, presence, new beginnings, the foundation of form
Orange	Sacral	2	Emotion: duality, feeling, the self first encountering the other
Yellow	Solar Plexus	3	Self: identity, personal power, will, the fire of individuation
Green	Heart	4	Heart: love, acceptance, foundation, stability made warm
Teal	Throat	5	Speech and Creation: voice, expression, pivot between below and above
Indigo	Third Eye	6	Thought and Consideration: inner vision, perception, the seer at work
Violet	Crown	7	Seeing: wisdom arrives, the vessel opens, knowing emerges from stillness
Silver	Soul Star	8	Receiving: the wide gathering field, inspiration before it enters the body
Gold	Soul Blueprint	9	Source: completion, universal love, compassion, humanitarian service

Layer 2+ · Master Numbers

When a card name reduces through a master number, that vibration is preserved in the card's notation. These cards carry amplified frequency. The master number and the final reduction are both honored.

Colors of Life Oracle Deck Guidance

Welcome to the practice of symbolic sight reading through the Intuography Colors of Life Oracle Deck. Intuography is an intuitive method that transforms photographs of people, places, animals, insects, plants, and flowers into energetic color expressions of the moment the image was taken. The number 9 appears consistently throughout the creation of the deck and carries symbolic significance.

The back of each card contains Metatron's Cube with concentric colorful circles and hypnotic swirls. This image represents an energetic field and a point of entry into symbolic perception.

The front of each card contains an Intuograph, along with colors used in energy healing, the card title, and a number. The title may be the name of a soul, a healing color, a scene, or a species. The number is the reduced cardinal value of the title, calculated through numerology, and reflects the energetic signature of the card.

When beginning a reading, remain neutral and open. Impressions related to the card may arise naturally. The colors carry meaning. The name may evoke someone known, or it may simply carry an energetic awareness. Allow whatever appears to be present and treat it as guidance.

Next, take time to look into the card. The two dimensional image may begin to reveal depth, movement, and form. Animals, flow, or an otherworldly quality may appear. Allow these impressions to emerge. When reading with another person, share what is seen and invite them to describe what they perceive as well. This shared observation deepens the reading.

To complete the reading, focus on the number associated with the card. Consider its shape, energy, and symbolic meaning. Study its significance through Pythagorean numerology resources and allow what is learned to guide interpretation.

When working with a multi card spread, place the cards next to each other and notice how their flows align from one to the next. Cards may connect side to side or top to bottom. Use how the images flow into each other to further inform the interpretation. Last, add the numbers of all cards and reduce them to a single digit. Read this final number as an additional layer of insight.
