My Path

- Trained at the Academy of Intuition Medicine®, an immersive program in energy medicine, clairvoyant healing, and group panel work.
- Developed Intuography as my graduation project: a method of transforming photographs into energetic oracle cards using color, numerology, and sacred geometry.
- Trained with the Jacquin Hypnosis Academy, Cohort 16
- Built Hypno Energetics to bridge energy medicine with hypnotherapy bringing the depth of intuitive perception into a practical clinical framework.
- Now sharing these tools with practitioners who want to go deeper with their clients.

What Is Intuography?



The Image

Photographs of people, places, animals, insects, plants, and flowers — transformed into energetic color expressions of the moment they were captured.



The Number

Each card carries a number — the reduced cardinal value of its title, calculated through Pythagorean numerology. This is the card's energetic signature.



The Perception

The reader enters a neutral, open state allowing impressions, colors, movement, and depth to arise naturally. Intuition without effort.

The number 9 appears consistently throughout the creation of the deck — carrying its own symbolic significance.

Pythagorean Numerology

Each card carries a number — the reduced cardinal value of its title. Every number is a frequency.

- 1** New beginnings, independence, leadership, individuality. The self initiating. Pioneer energy. The spark before the flame.
- 2** Duality, partnership, sensitivity, receptivity. The space between. Diplomacy, intuition, and the art of listening.
- 3** Creativity, expression, joy, communication. The number of art and play. Where imagination becomes form.
- 4** Foundation, structure, stability, discipline. The builder. Grounded effort and the wisdom of limitation.
- 5** Freedom, change, adventure, the senses. The explorer. Movement, adaptability, and the courage to transform.
- 6** Harmony, responsibility, love, service. The nurturer. Beauty, family, and the healing power of compassion.
- 7** Mystery, introspection, spirituality, analysis. The seeker. Solitude, depth, and the inner life of the soul.
- 8** Power, abundance, karma, mastery. The achiever. Material and spiritual balance. What is given returns.
- 9** Completion, universal love, wisdom, humanitarianism. The teacher. All numbers dissolve into 9. It always returns to itself.

Examples: 'Colors of Life' = 63 → 9 · 'Metatron' = 34 → 7 · '3rd Eye' = 30 → 3 · Each title's frequency is encoded into the card.

The Transformation

Source photograph → Intuograph

A rainbow descends to the crown.*



The surface image becomes an interior landscape.

Earth tones, crimson, sage, and black flow as geological strata — the depth of a person rendered visible.

The rainbow at the crown does not disappear. It was always already there. The process reveals what the photograph could only suggest.

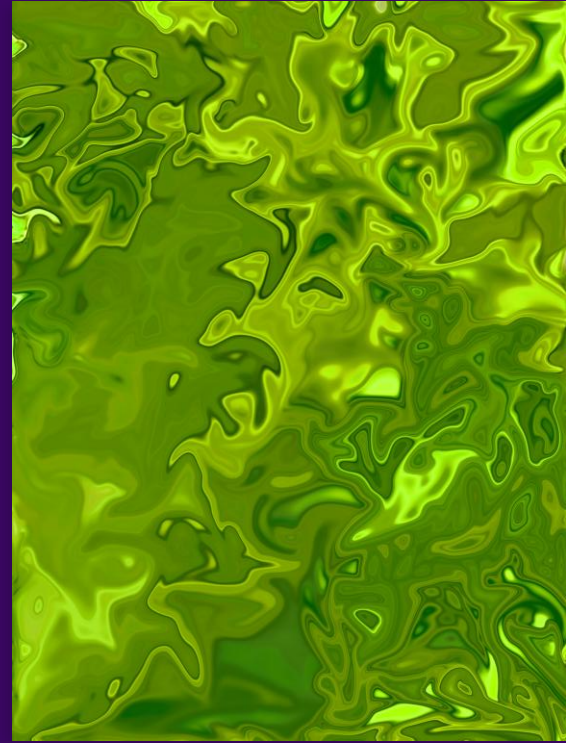
The Transformation

*The creature dissolves into pure mantis-ness.
Look carefully — what do you see in the green?
"I didn't put it there."*

How the Cards Work

1

Enter Neutrality

Remain open and receptive. Allow impressions related to the card to arise naturally. Colors carry meaning. The name may evoke someone known, or simply an energetic awareness.

2

Look Into the Card

The 2D image may reveal depth, movement, and form. Animals, flow, or otherworldly qualities may appear. When reading with another person, share what you see and invite them to describe their perceptions too.

3

Read the Number

Focus on the Pythagorean numerological value of the card. Consider its shape, energy, and symbolic meaning. Allow what is learned to guide interpretation.

4

Multi-Card Spreads

Place cards beside each other. Notice how their flows align, side to side, top to bottom. Add all numbers and reduce to a single digit for a final layer of insight.

Three Modes of Use

The primary distinction between a fun and a therapeutic approach.

1

Practitioner Interprets

Direct knowing — practitioner-led

When Michael reads a card, he often knows the source, who was photographed, what moment was captured, what energy was alive in the room. His interpretation is informed by direct knowledge of the image's origin.

This is the more precise instrument, layered, specific, and grounded in the actual energetic event the image carries.

Depth · Precision · Direct transmission

2

Client Leads

Free projection — therapeutically driven

The card is offered without context. The client speaks freely, what they see, what it evokes, what arises without effort. The practitioner follows, not leads.

The image becomes a mirror. The meaning that emerges belongs entirely to the client, which is precisely why it lands so deeply. The unconscious speaks through the symbol it is given.

Projection · Self-discovery · Client-generated meaning

3

Context Offered

A frame without a conclusion — collaborative

Sometimes Michael offers a single line of context: 'This was taken during a moment of someone cracking open in class.' No more than that.

One sentence opens a door without pointing through it. The client now holds both their own perception and the knowledge of the image's origin, and something new emerges in the space between the two.

Invitation · Collaboration · Held lightly

The Hypnosis Connection

*Intuography does what a good induction does,
it moves the client below the critical faculty before you've said a word.*

Hypnotherapy

Bypass the critical faculty

Access the subconscious

Work through symbol & metaphor

Personalized suggestion

Client generates the meaning



Intuography

Neutral receptive state — no analysis required

Symbolic image opens the deeper perceptive layer

Color, form & numerology as living metaphor

Card title & number anchor personal insight

Reader & client co-perceive and co-create

Hypno Energetics — The Session

1

Mindful Inquiry

A focused conversation using simple questions to reveal what matters most right now. Thoughts, emotions, and body cues are used as information. The real pattern becomes clear.

Pre-talk & pattern recognition

2

Intuography Card Reading

The client selects a card. Both reader and client observe what arises — color, depth, movement, impression. The symbolic layer opens before the induction begins.

Bridge to the subconscious

3

Meditative Guidance

Guided meditation supports calm, grounded awareness — creating space for insight beyond mental noise. This is the induction, arriving naturally from the card state.

Hypnotic induction

4

Hypnotic Suggestion

Personalized hypnotic language supports new internal agreements, healthier responses, and steadier confidence — aligned with what the card reading revealed.

Suggestion & integration

5

Aligned Action

The session closes with practical integration. Steps are clear, doable, and designed to create momentum. The card image serves as a post-hypnotic anchor.

Post-session anchoring

Two Decks — Two Doorways

Deck One

Intuography See and Say Oracle Deck

- Photographs taken mid-class, one willing, consenting person at a time, in genuine moments of spiritual opening and wild self-expression
- Each image transformed through Intuography, rendered as the energetic color signature of that moment
- Card back: Colors of Life, a complete map of the creative process, crown to earth, held in the radiant aura field
- Original: 63 cards (6+3=9) · Final: 69 cards
- Not for sale, offered as gifts. A practice, not a product.

Deck Two

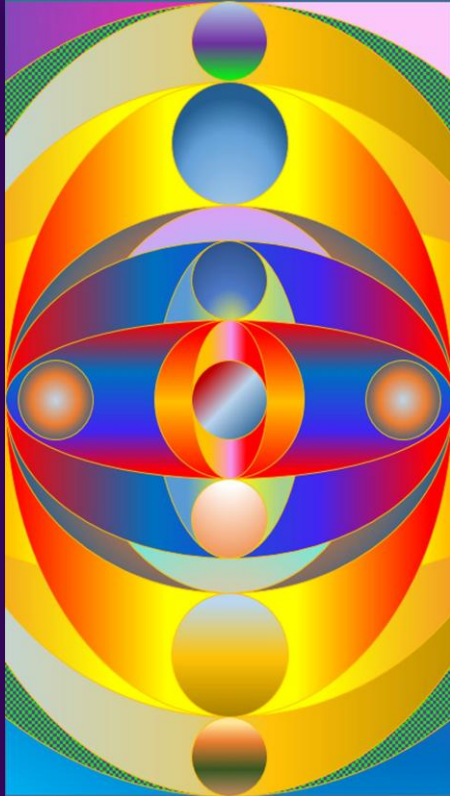
Intuography Colors of Life Oracle Deck

- People, animals, and scenes, all with consent. Animal subjects gave their own consent: the squirrel sat and looked up; the snake paused on the path; the mantis turned and held Michael's gaze.
- Card back: Metatron's Swirls, 13 spiraling chakra-colored spheres in the Fruit of Life geometry, crown at center
- 72 cards (7+2=9). Every Photoshop tool setting reduced to 9, encoded into the pixel structure of every image. Most of the time.
- Contains the Colors of Life card (#9) and Metatron's Swirls card (#7)

Colors of Life — The Creative Process as Map



7th · Crown

Inspiration arrives from the ether

6th · Third Eye

Seen, visualized, worked through

5th · Throat

Spoken into being, See and Say

4th · Heart

Accepted and radiated outward

3rd · Solar Plexus

Identified with, owned

2nd · Sacral

Emoted and felt

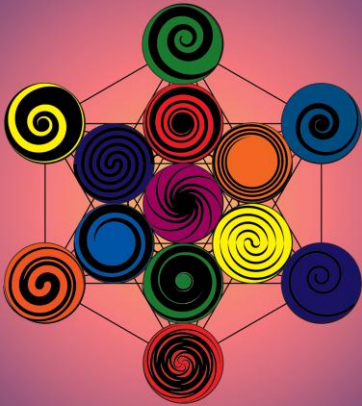
1st · Root

Grounded and released into the Earth

The outer rings: the radiant, fluctuating aura — holding field for the entire creative arc.

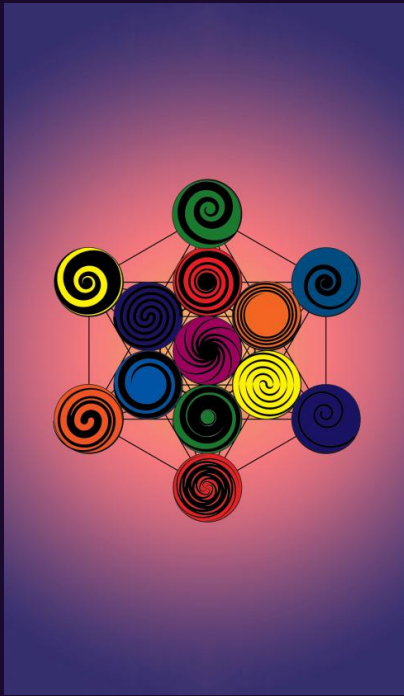
Deck Two — The Card Back

Metatron's Swirls — Sacred Geometry as Living Spiral



- 13 spiraling spheres arranged in the Fruit of Life, the foundation of Metatron's Cube, and alive. Each node a spinning vortex, not a static point.
- Chakra colors distributed through the geometry. The 7th chakra, Crown, sits at the center. Spirit is not above. It is at the heart of everything.
- For hypnotherapists: 13 simultaneous spiral focal points, a natural eye fixation field that primes the client for symbolic receptivity before a word is spoken. Slow rotation motion graphic is used as an induction tool.
- Appears on the back of all 72 cards in the deck, with a card in the deck, the moment when the container becomes the content, the background becomes the foreground.
- Also appears on the top of the box. The “Colors of Life” appears on the bottom, grounded source beneath the spinning field.

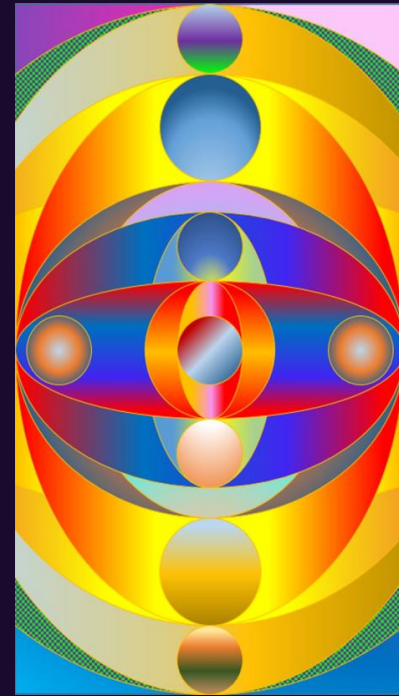


TOP OF BOX

Metatron's Swirls — the spinning field

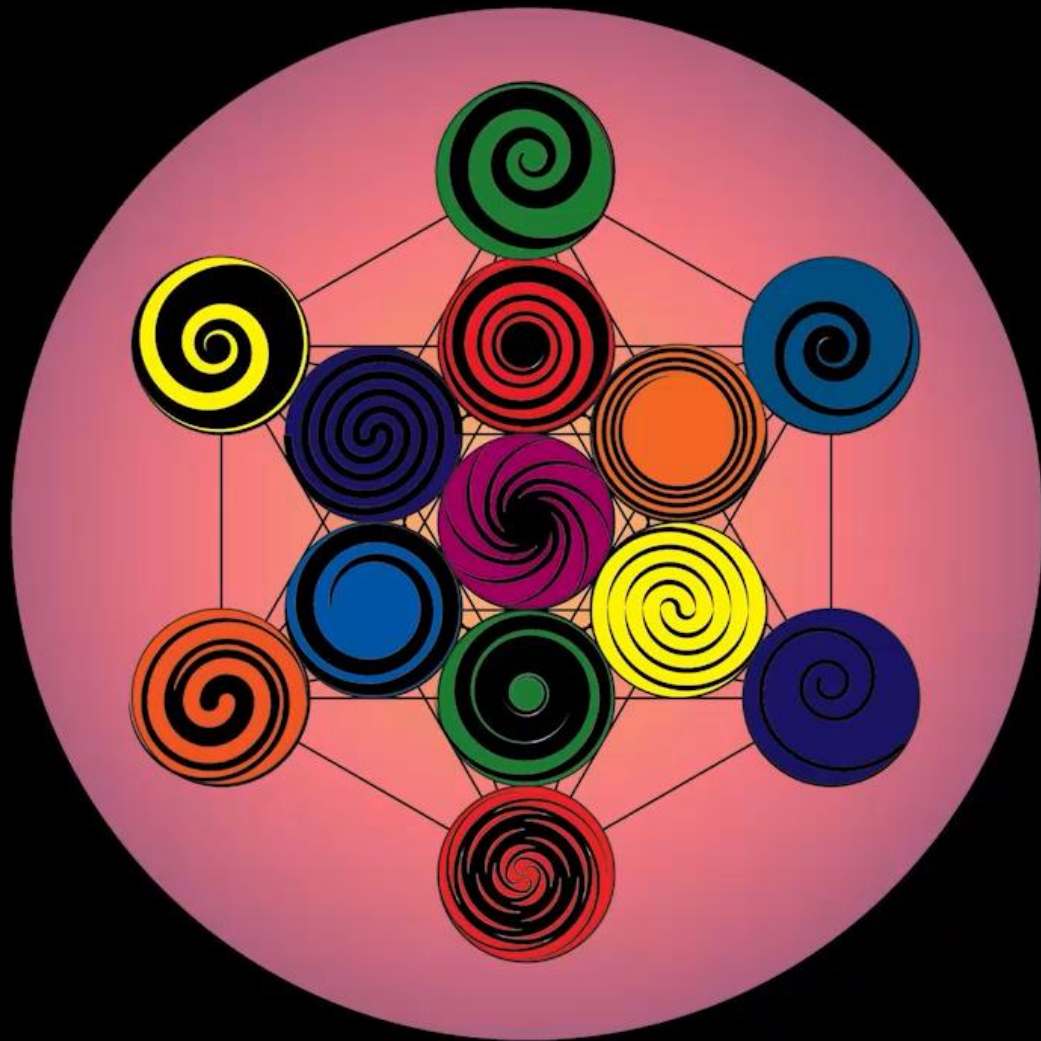

The Number 9

Deck One: 63 cards · $6+3 = 9$

Deck Two: 72 cards · $7+2 = 9$

Colors of Life card: #9

$9 \times 8 = 72$ · 9 Always returns to itself

Every Photoshop tool setting reduced to 9

The number 9 appears consistently throughout the creation

How You Can Use This In Your Practice

Pre-Induction Tool

Ask the client to select a card before the session begins. What they notice, what it evokes, becomes an additional source for your suggestion work. The card has already begun the induction.

Post-Hypnotic Anchor

Most sessions are online. Michael asks clients to take a screenshot or photo of their card before the session ends. The image on their phone becomes a portable anchor, available anywhere, anytime, between appointments.

Pattern Elicitation

Ask the client to choose three cards as past, present, and future. What they see reveals the pattern they're working with, often more quickly than direct questioning.

Rapport & Opening

Fan the deck and let the client choose. Discuss what drew them to that card. In two minutes you know what metaphors resonate, and your suggestions will land much deeper.

Eye Fixation

The back of the card, Metatron's Swirls with 13 simultaneous spiraling focal points, is a natural eye fixation field. It primes dissociation and focused attention before you've said a word.

Group Work

In workshops, have each participant select a card and share one word, the first that comes to mind, without 2nd guess. This creates rapid group rapport and surfaces the themes the group is collectively working with.
