This is what I sent [REDACTED] who we have known for years is a special linguist with a U.S. military defense agency. We don't know which agency and don't plan on knowing. [REDACTED] occasionally goes to theaters of war, we know that. [REDACTED] is in the same military line of work. They do this exact work, so they were both interested when I brought it up on the Zoom [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. I decided to send it to them, as I mentioned a few weeks ago. Hi [REDACTED],

I was greatly impressed to hear you and your [REDACTED] speak about your work on our Zoom version of a [REDACTED]. Thank you, also, for expressing an interest in my work as a member of the Task Force on Countering Disinformation, established by Chief Justice Robert Brutinel on September 18, 2019. See Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2019-114. I am attaching for your comments and suggestions my study on TheRobingRoom.com. The two page memo attached hereto as the first attachment gives an overview of my work, and should be read first. In addition, there are five attachments (A through E), which represent the bulk of my work on linguistic traits of the derogatory postings that lead me to suspect a common origin and authorship, as well as an intent to discredit the U.S. judiciary in the eyes of the public. (TheRobingRoom.com covers the judiciary in all 50 states.)

A few words about TheRobingRoom.com. Based upon Google, it is the property of North Law

Publishers, Inc. and is located at the address of the two lawyers who founded North Law Publishers, Richard W. Levitt and Nicholas Kaiser, of the Levitt and Kaiser law firm. The address is 40 Fulton Street, 23<sup>rd</sup> Floor, N.Y., N.Y. Their phone numbers and the other two members of their law firm are listed on their website. They also publish an annual edition of New York Rules of Court. Both attorneys, according to their LinkedIn entries, are highly respected for their criminal defense representation. Mr. Levitt notably co-represented (with another attorney) some intervenor/victims in the Bernie Madoff bankruptcy. The FAQs of The RobingRoom.com mention that the postings are reviewed for libelous material. The actual postings on numerous judges, however, charge the judges with accepting bribes and other crimes and in more than a few instances incite hatred and violence against them.
