The right of The People to petition their government for Redress of Grievances is the right to make a complaint to or seek the assistance of one's government without fear of punishment or reprisals.

*We the People* are now demanding that our elected officials honor the oath to the Constitution of the United States and Our State of Arizona YOU publicly swore upon entering into elected office!

Article 2, Section 21 of the Arizona Constitution states that, "All elections shall be free and equal, and no power, civil or military, shall at any time interfere to prevent the free exercise of the right of suffrage." Article 7, Section 7 states, "In all elections held by the people in this state, the person, or persons, receiving the highest number of LEGAL votes shall be declared elected." You and your colleagues do not have the right to interfere with *We the People's* right to know that every vote counted was a legal vote, free from illegal or illegitimate acts. It is your duty to represent the best interests of the citizens of this county and NOT the interests of yourselves and your colleagues, or worse...unknown powers or sources of influence – financial or otherwise!

Honor your Oath and stand up for the peoples sacred right to a Free and Fair election. If what you, and the Board of Supervisors say is true, you should have nothing to lose, and nothing to hide.

Comply with the subpoenas and give the people what is due them by our Constitution. A full and comprehensive forensic analysis of the election equipment and software that is paid for and owned by the Maricopa County taxpayers.

We have been patient, we have exercised restraint and we have listened to you talk. We are respectfully demanding that you respond to this request by December 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020 by 4:00pm.
