- include a title for the presentation
- indicate who will make the presentation and include:
 - name of contact person, address, telephone number and email address
 - name of presenter, address, telephone number and email address
- describe the purpose of the research or the innovative program
- describe in detail the innovative program or methodology used (design of project, sample size, site/participant selection criteria, data collection method(s), data analysis technique(s), response rate)
- provide a summary of findings and indicate grade level(s): **primary, intermediate, or high school**
- explain the implications for education
- **include AV needs: LCD projector or Overhead (YOU MUST PROVIDE YOUR OWN COMPUTER)**
- related to at least one of the four topic areas listed above
