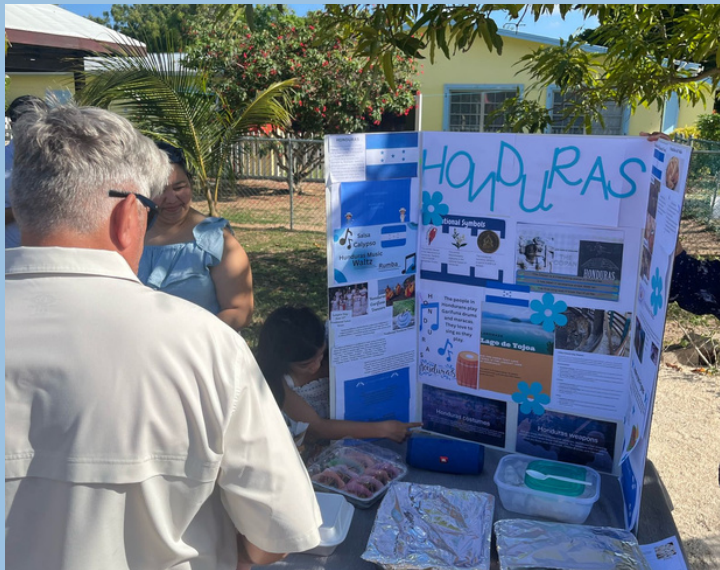
Helping Hands Club
