

RULES FOR THE BROADHEAD SHOOT

NO ONE ALLOWED ON RANGES UNTIL SUNDAY AT 7:30 AM IF SEEN YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED

Florida Bowhunters Council maintains authority over the Jamboree rules.

Florida Bowhunters Council reserves the right to restrict use of certain types of equipment.

Shooting Start and Stop times will be announced by use of an air horn. (IN CASE OF EMERGENCY RANGE STOPS WITH 5 HORN BLAST)

Violation of any of the Jamboree Rules constitutes grounds for disqualification.

Your Numbered Scalp must be visibly displayed on your person or equipment, **at all times**, while shooting on the range.

Your Score Card must be in your possession while shooting on range.

1. Bows must have a minimum draw weight of 35 pounds, for competing adults.
2. Arrow(s) must have a BROADHEAD with at least two blades and be at least 7/8" wide to compete for a trophy. Expandable practice blades can be used.
3. **Broad heads must be kept in covered quivers while on the range.**
4. Shoot the range of your choice on Sunday and the opposite range on Monday. **(Only one range is to be shot each day by a competitor)**
5. On Sunday, competition begins at 7:30A.M. And ends at 4:00 PM.
6. On Monday, competition begins at 7:30 AM and ends at 2:30PM
7. Score cards must be filled out including number of kills and total score, turned in to pole barn **by 3:00 on Monday.**
8. While shooting, you must be touching the shooting stake.
9. Shoot only one arrow at each target.
10. To tally a score, **the arrow shaft** breaks through the score line.
11. Do not break or remove limbs, branches or foliage that may be in your line of fire while shooting, targets are placed in this manner to create actual hunting conditions.
12. **No** range finders allowed. **No** laser sites, of any type, allowed.
13. **No practicing in campsite or on either range, at any time.**
14. Field points must be used when shooting novelty shoots.
15. **Archery equipment is not allowed outside the campsite or the target ranges. (Per State Law you could be fined if stopped)**
16. **CUBS:** Under 13 years old, **Must be with an adult, broadheads not required.**
17. **YOUTH:** 13 years old to 17 years old. **Must be with an adult** Use the same rules as Men's and Women's Adult.
18. **TRADITIONAL:** No sight, No mechanical release, No compound bows.
19. **MENS & WOMANS ADULT:** Sights, only fixed pin or rear movable type sights allowed.
20. **No Parking Vehicles East Side of Tram Road at Yellow RANGE.**
