Removed gas tank, inside cleaned to bare metal, fuel lines blown out, all hose lines changed, new fuel sending unit, carburetor rebuilt, adjusted valves, oil changed, plugs cleaned. And this baby started right up! I like the manual choke.

I was told this had a frame off restoration and was ready to get engine and trans rebuilt when it was left to sit. I drove around the block, the engine purrs, and tranny shifts fine. Interior is also new as well as trunk area.

The motor runs for the convertible top but it does not engage. I have not inspected the brakes but it does pull to one side when braking. I have not noticed any leaks yet.
