These Tournaments are a great way for you to evaluate your skill level, identify needed training areas, improve your qualification scores, and practice your handgun skills to keep you prepared for the ever-increasing dangers you face on the street and off duty.

#### ~ NEW SHOOTERS ~

You do NOT need any fancy gear or guns to start shooting these matches. Just bring your duty handgun, three magazines, holster & magazine pouch. There is nothing to memorize, the course will be announced as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and fellow officers will gladly help you out. You can even use your stock duty gun to fire the Open Class Division Matches if you have four magazines. This will let you see what the other matches are like and how challenging

## and fun these matches are.

**Governing Rules:** Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at **ppc.nra.org**.

**SAFETY:** All safety rules of the NRA, SCCJA, and the SCPCL will be enforced. Safety violations will be grounds for removal from the firing line. Major violations can cause disqualification. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy property.

**Individual Eligibility:** Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4. These include active and retired Law Enforcement Officers, and <u>full time</u> Police Firearms Instructors, Transit Police, Penal Institution Guards, Industrial Police which includes Bank Guards and Armored and Express Company Guards, and Military Police. Federal Flight Deck Officers who

hold valid certifications are also eligible.

NRA Membership is not required but encouraged. Discounted NRA Membership Forms for Law Enforcement

Make sure you bring your agency credentials or other paperwork showing your eligibility with you to show when you check in.

**Registration:** You may register on-site, but **Pre-Registration is highly recommended** to be guaranteed a slot. Please complete the Competitor Registration Form found at the end of this announcement and follow the submission instructions listed.

**Classification:** Individual competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and new shooters with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2. Competitors may check their current NRA Classification at **LEcompetitions.nra.org.** 

**Tournament Fees:** Entry fees will be collected on the day of the Tournament with payment made in cash or by check. Where applicable, fees include NRA Match Fees

Shooters are also encouraged to bring a competitor who has never competed in the South Carolina State Championships before. New competitors and their sponsor will **receive a discount of ten dollars off the package price**. Let us know when you register at the range and the credit will be given. If you have Pre-Registered, the fees will be adjusted accordingly and refunded.

## **Major Prize Table Awards:**

- Unclassified shooters will compete in the High Master Class (Rule 19.2)
- Overall Class Champions will be based on the shooter's Open Gun Classification
- Maximum (1) gun awarded per competitor If a shooter has been awarded a gun in a previous match, the next eligible shooter in the match will be awarded the gun.

### Notes!

- Please note that awards are presented to S.C. Police Combat League members only.
- Overall Champion scoring is based on an aggregate of the following matches:
  - Open Class
  - o Duty Gun Match
  - Highest Distinguished Match (Revolver or Semiauto)
- The Production Distinguished Match is <u>NOT</u> included in the aggregate score. You are, however, highly encouraged to shoot that match!

## **Major Prize Winners:**

<u>Due to recent changes in Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (BATFE) firearm transaction requirements</u>, firearms will not be physically present to be awarded as prizes. Winners of major prizes will receive either a coupon for the firearm from a local firearms retail supporter, or a gift card of like value to such a supporter in the Columbia area.

**Business Meeting Lunch:** Will begin immediately after the last match is fired and recorded. Awards will be presented after lunch. Must be a member of the South Carolina Police Combat League to submit a vote.

**Targets:** Official NRA B-27 Targets will be used.

**Scoring:** Competitor scoring will be used by passing your scorecards to the competitor on your right who will score the targets of the competitor to their left. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target NOR may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets.

PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors.

**Score Cards:** All score cards <u>must</u> be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing. Once a score card is signed and turned in, <u>only</u> a Match Official can alter the card and will initial the change.

Sighting Shots: No sighting shots are allowed.

#### **Course of Fire Information:**

**Time Limits:** Time Limits will be announced for each stage or match. Time will start with loaded gun in the holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun until the command to commence firing is given.

**Firing Method:** Matches or stages designated as double action must be fired double action. Matches or stages designated as single action may be fired either single or double action. All double action semi-automatic pistols must fire the first shot of every stage double action except at the 50 yard line.

**Loading:** To force reloading under time restraints and magazines are loaded with a maximum of 6 rounds. There is no limit on the number of magazines or speedloaders you have but after initial loading all ammunition used during the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person.

**Distinguished Revolver and Semi-Auto Matches:** Firearms will be selected at random to be inspected and triggers weighed. See PPC Rule 3.4 and 3.5 respectively for firearm specifications.

## PRODUCTION DUTY OPTIC PISTOLS Rule 3.10.1

In addition to the specifications within Section 3.1, and 3.10, the following specifications apply for Production Duty Optic Pistols.

Firearm / Caliber: Pistols meeting the specifications for Production Pistols in Section 3.10 and are listed as Approved in Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 14.1 may be equipped with an Approved non-magnified optic suitable for duty use.

The Duty Optic must be listed as Approved by NRA Law Enforcement Competitions in Police Pistol Combat Bullet 19.1 on the Law Enforcement Competitions website.

To be considered for approval, Duty Optics must mount without any modification to the handgun as originally manufactured. Swapping the original slide to an aftermarket slide with optic mount cuts is <u>not</u> allowed since the handgun is no longer as originally manufactured.

The pistol should have co-witnessed front and rear sights, but the rear sight may be removed to mount the Duty Optic or to use a Stock Optic Ready Plate.

All Other Specifications are the same as Production Pistols

All double action semi-automatic pistols must fire the first shot of every stage double action except at the 50 yard line.

#### PRODUCTION SEMI-AUTOMATIC PISTOL

In addition to the specifications within Section 3.1, the following specifications apply for Production Semi-Automatic Pistols.

Firearm / Caliber: Approved Pistols for this Division are listed in Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 14.1 on the Law Enforcement Competitions website. To be considered for approval the pistol must be a mass produced center-fire semi-automatic pistol made for police or military use (at least 1,000 pistols), a stock catalog item that is unmodified from its original factory condition, and have a double, double/single, or striker type action. Double/single actions pistols must have a manual decocking device, or equipped with an automatic decocker that returns the pistol to double action mode when the slide is released. All double/single action and double action pistols must

fire the first shot of every stage double action.

#### **OFF DUTY SEMI-AUTOMATIC PISTOL** Rule 3.9 In addition to the specifications within Section 3.1, the following specifications apply for Off Duty Semi-Automatic Pistols. Firearm / Caliber: A stock factory manufactured (catalog item) semi-automatic center-fire pistol suitable for off duty concealed carry, chambered for and capable of firing .380 caliber ammunition or larger. All double action pistols must fire the first shot of every match or stage double action. In addition to the specifications within Section 3.1, and 3.10, the following specifications apply for Production Duty Optic Pistols.

Firearm / Caliber: Pistols meeting the specifications for Production Pistols in Section 3.10 and are listed as Approved in Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 14.1 may be equipped with an Approved non-magnified optic suitable for duty use.

The Duty Optic must be listed as Approved by NRA Law Enforcement Competitions in Police Pistol Combat Bullet 19.1 on the Law Enforcement Competitions website.

To be considered for approval, Duty Optics must mount without any modification to the handgun as originally manufactured. Swapping the original slide to an aftermarket slide with optic mount cuts is <u>not</u> allowed since the handgun is no longer as originally manufactured.

The pistol should have co-witnessed front and rear sights, but the rear sight may be removed to mount the Duty Optic or to use a Stock Optic Ready Plate.

All Other Specifications are the same as Production Pistols

## 3.10.2 Off Duty Production Optic Pistol:

Off Duty Production Optic Pistol Pistols must meet the specifications in Section 3.10.1 for Production Duty Optic Pistols, be listed as Approved in Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 14.1 and have a maximum Barrel Length of 3.75 inches.

Approved nonmagnified duty optics listed as Approved by NRA Law Enforcement Competitions in Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 19.1 on the Law Enforcement Competitions website may be used.

These Pistols may be fired in the Off Duty Production Optic Pistol Match and Production Duty Optic Pistol Match.

For Classification purposes, the shooters Production Duty Optic Pistol Classification will be used. See Rule Book Section 19.1 for PPC Classifications.
