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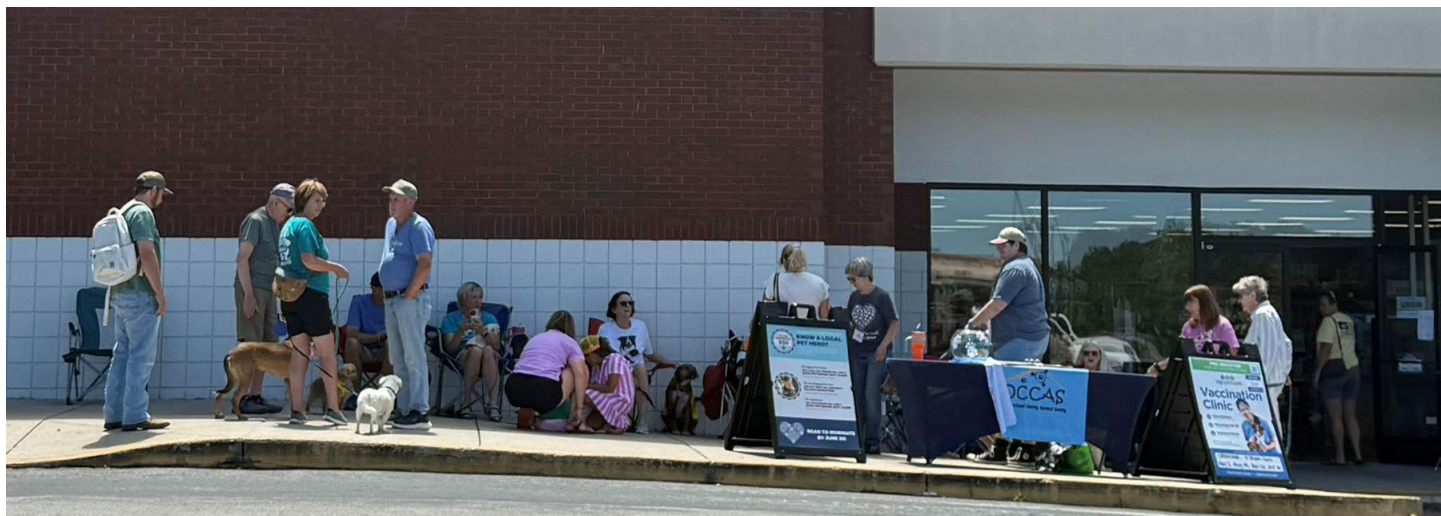

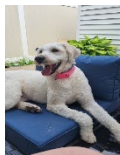
A New Meaning for National Hot Dog Month... and Don't Forget Our Cool Cats



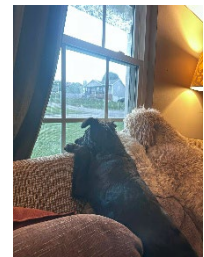

The BISSELL Pet Foundation is a 501(c)(3) national animal welfare organization founded in 2011 by Cathy Bissell, dedicated to reducing pet homelessness. It is widely considered an excellent organization for animal rescues, focusing on directly assisting overburdened rescues, providing spay/neuter services, and sponsoring massive adoption events.

Key Facts About the BISSELL Pet Foundation

- Mission: To help reduce the number of animals in rescues through adoption, transport, spaying/neutering, vaccination, microchipping, and crisis/disaster response programs.
- Impact: The foundation has assisted more than 1 million pets nationwide and partners with over 5,200 animal welfare organizations.
- 100% Impact Promise: Because BISSELL Inc. covers administrative costs, 100% of public donations go directly to pet-saving programs.

Key Programs:

- Empty the Shelters™: The nation's largest funded adoption event, reducing adoption fees to help shelters empty their kennels. To date, Bissell has helped FOCCAS place over 80 cats and, most recently, a litter of puppies.
- Crisis & Disaster Response: Rapidly helps rescue and shelter in crises ranging from hurricanes to hoarding situations.
