On September 12-15, at Springfield-Beckly Municipal Airport in Springfield, Ohio, the Great War Aeroplanes Association (GWAA) hosted the rebranded version of the Dawn Patrol Rendezvous. The last event was held in 2022 at the National Museum of the United States Air Force in Dayton, Ohio, and was a recurring event every two years starting in 2003.
