Here is a club and community success story I would like to share with you. In 2012, I attended a fly in hosted by the Buc-Le Aero Sportsman of Quakertown, Pennsylvania. This was a large and successful event and I intended to return, however the club stopped having the event for various reasons.

Last fall I received the following email from Travis Moyer, president of the Buc-Le Aero Sportsman.

"Mark, I just wanted to follow up with you on our relaunched Giant Scale event that took place September 14-15, 2019. The biggest change we made was designating that all proceeds would benefit charitable organizations.

"The organizations we chose were the Bucks County SPCA and the Trumbauersville Fire Company, which is roughly a mile down the road from our facility.

"The event went well, with 43 pilots registered, which is a higher average registration than we had had in past events. In total, we raised \$1,444 with \$722 going to each organization.

"We were happy with the outcome and also happy that our club could give back to the community in which our facility resides as a result of the generous donations from our registered pilots and attending spectators."
