As you may or may not be aware, AMA has money available to assist your club in making improvements to your flying facility by utilizing the Flying Site Assistance grant. I would like to share how a club in Pennsylvania took advantage of the program to improve its flying field.

The following is from Jack Gilbert, president of the Tri-County Wing Snappers (TCWS).

The members of TCWS would like to thank the AMA team responsible for selecting our club as one of this year's winners of the 2017 Flying Site Assistance grant. The award we received went immediately toward completing the projects necessary to make the transition to our new flying site.

Back in August 2016 we first entered into a three-month provisional agreement with the landlord, just to be sure both parties would be happy with the RC activity taking place on this private airfield. We had a small plastic storage shed and that was it!

That period ended successfully and we entered into a formal, two-year agreement effective January 1, 2017. On the morning of March 3, we had the ground excavation all completed and the stone bed laid and rolled to be the base of our new main area of nonflying activities. By the end of the day,









we had our more permanent sheds positioned and our belongings stored inside.

On June 25, we held our first outdoor meeting of the year at our site. We had our pavilion canopy complete, our new grass was growing strong, and we brought in 10 of the previous members who had not yet rejoined because of the uncertainty of our field situation. We have yet to solve our long-term electric supply issue, but other than that our new facility is basically complete.

On behalf of the membership of TCWS, once again, thank you for your support and for honoring us with the

2017 grant, enabling us to complete our new field transformation process.

Thank you TCWS for utilizing the funds available from AMA to improve your club's facilities. I would encourage the clubs in District III to look at your flying facilities, choose a project that
