

What an amazing story: to start a Scale competition for beginners and it is still going strong 30 years later! Bill moved from Ohio and went south a few years ago to be closer to family and some good fishing, but I am told he still promotes Scale flying in his area.

The District III Scale modeling world owes a debt of gratitude to Bill for having the foresight to see the need to create an event for novice Scale modelers to be introduced to flying in RC Scale competition. Thank you, Bill, for your dedication to model aviation. We are looking forward to the 31st edition of the Bob Evans Scale event in 2019.
