Bill goes on to say that he enlisted in the Army in World War II and fought in Normandy on D-Day and in the Battle of the Bulge. Bill turned 21 on a ship coming home from Europe, later met his future wife, and has been happily married for 69 years.

Bill, now 93, believes he was the first RC flier in his area and "built a high-wing stable airplane and built a ground-based transmitter." Bill is a founding member of the Sayre RC Club that has existed for more than 50 years. He recently moved into Sayre Health Care Center and is mostly confined to a wheelchair.

After reading this beautifully written letter, I contacted my associate vice president in the area, Dan Luchaco, and asked him to visit Bill and present him with the AMA Award of Recognition.

Thank you, Bill, for all you have done for the betterment of model aviation and the AMA. I cannot think of a more deserving individual for this award than Bill Cowles.
