On June 2, 2018, I attended the Lehigh Valley Radio Control Society (LVRCS) Ellis Grumer Electric Fly and EDF Meet in Easton, Pennsylvania. This is roughly a 6-hour drive for me, so I arrived on Friday and had weather concerns because the news media was reporting there could be record flooding in the area for the weekend. Could this be like Joe Nall and be canceled due to weather?

of electric motors, batteries, ESCs, and more. Thank you Lehigh Valley RC Society for keeping Ellis' legacy of electric RC flight alive now and into the future.

On June 15, 2018, I attended the Ohio Waterfront Vintage Gathering hosted by the Westerville Model Aeronautics Association (WMAA) in Galena, Ohio. This event celebrates the pioneers of RC flight and is a Vintage RC Society (VRCS) event.

In the 1960s, I grew up admiring RC leaders such as Ed Kazmerski and Phil Kraft and aircraft including the Kwick Fli and the Taurus. VRCS events are designed to celebrate these RC pioneers and their aircraft. This was the first-ever VRCS event in the Ohio area, and CD Jean-Marie Piednoir did a fine job of running it.

If you want to see the roots of RC, you need to build and fly one of these early RC models and try performing loops and rolls with rudder and throttle only. It took great skill to fly these aircraft, let alone perform aerobatics with radio systems that were unreliable at best. Today is we can fly these aircraft with modern radio and engines in a safe and reliable manor. Thanks to WMAA and the VRCS for reminding us how RC got to where it is today.
