## Effective February 6, 2023 GME TRASH AND RECYCLING SCHEDULE

## **Abbreviated Ordinance Information:**

Trash and Recycling receptacles are not to be set curbside prior to 9:00pm on the day preceding the scheduled day of collection and no later than 6:00am on the scheduled day of collection. No plastic bags permitted in recycling containers.

Residential Properties: Limited to (2) two 96-gallon cans with appropriate lift bar or (6) 32 gallon receptacles not weighing more than 50lbs each. Commercial Properties: limited to (3) three 96gallon cans with appropriate lift bar. Hotels/Motels: limited to (1) one 96-gallon can with appropriate lift bar for every (4) rental units. Effective May 1, 2023 Commercial, Hotel and Motel Properties may not use 32 gallon trash receptacles.

**Bulk-Trash:** Residents, on their last scheduled trash day of the month, may put one bulk item weighing 75lbs or less (Excluding Mattresses), out with their trash. Local ordinances requires that cloth covered furniture be wrapped in plastic or the item will not be taken.
