Mentoring Educators in Inclusive Best Practice

a framework for school leaders

School leaders play a decisive role in whether inclusive practices move from slides into classrooms. This 90-minute session equips principals, assistant principals, learning services leads, and coaches with a simple but effective **3-part mentoring** framework that scaffolds teacher skill development over time. Leaders will learn how to target a high-leverage practice, model it in bite-sized steps, and guide teachers through evidence, application, and reflection so confidence builds, and real gains happen with students.

Learning Outcomes

- 1. Select a high-impact inclusive practice and define a clear success criterion aligned to your school context.
- Coach using a 3-part mentoring framework (Observe & Align → Model & Micro-Practice → Implement & Reflect).
- 3. **Collect** quick, low-burden evidence of impact (student work samples, short observation notes) to inform next steps.
- 4. Adapt the mentoring cycle for different roles (teacher, EA, team) and varying readiness levels.
- 5. Plan a 4-6 week rollout with checkpoints, feedback scripts, and escalation routes for added support.
