Life Science Supply List



NOTE: Notebooks are an integral part of your science class. A handout on how to organize your notebook is given at Orientation. The objective is to have your notebook ready by our first class. **Bring it to class.**

1. **Safety goggles** – provided by the teacher
2. **Gloves** – provided by the teacher
3. **1.5” three-ring binder** (For all school work done at home and in class.)
4. **8 Dividers** (The notebook assessment includes neatness, so consider this, especially about labels staying put.)
5. **2 packages of notebook paper & 1 ream of computer paper** –
REAM plus NOTEBOOK PAPER - SET ASIDE AT HOME FOR USE ONLY FOR OUR CLASS
6. **4 rolls of Paper Towels** - Bring rolls to FIRST class and turn in to teacher.
(Please bring Select-a-size. I will collect them, when roll is called.)
7. **4 - Red pens** (**REQUIRED** to have **in** your notebook.)
8. **Pencils** for school work and lab class (Mechanical type preferred due to no need for pencil sharpener.)
9. **Pencil bag for 3-ring binder** (In the front for writing tools. Put the colored pencils handed out at Orientation.)
10. **Calculator** (A basic \$1 calculator is needed for **bio**. (It is essential to have for school work & available for **each** class. Calculators can be stored in pencil bag, so keep this in mind when buying.)
11. **Sheet protectors** (Minimum of 5 – Additional ones may be wanted for certain handouts.)
